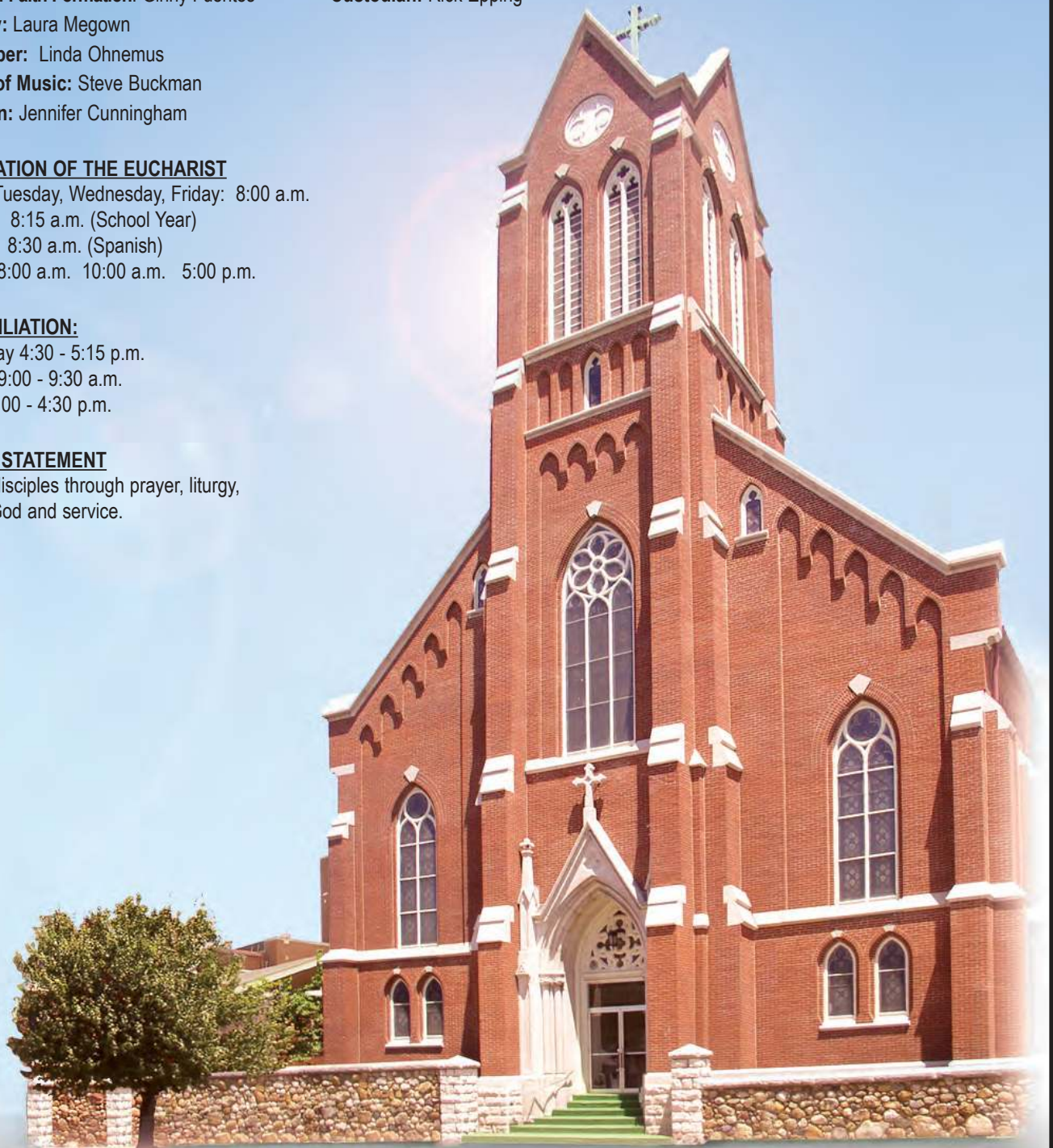

Breast Cancer Awareness. According to [cancer.org](http://cancer.org) breast cancer is the second most diagnosed cancer in women. In fact 1 in 8 women will develop breast cancer in their lifetime. That's a 13% chance. What's concerning is many diagnosed women reported no previous symptoms prior to diagnosis. The American Cancer Society recommends women between the ages of 45 and 54 get yearly mammograms, and some should even consider starting at age 40 depending on their history.
