

"On The Q/T..."

From "A Simple Path: Mother Teresa of Calcutta," by Lucinda Varney: "We must grow in love and to do this we must go on loving and loving and giving and giving until it hurts - the way Jesus did....You must give what will cost you something...not just what you can live without, but what you can't live without, something you really like. Then your gift becomes a sacrifice."

On to the question from Fr. Tony:

In years of spiritual direction, I've never met with resistance over the thought of giving something up that has to do with the false self, or with finding "the real me." But sacrifice of something that is good, and is the real part of me? And to offer it because it's good? Watch the hesitation there! So try this for thought: giving the way Mother Teresa says...what's that supposed to do, that God would ask that of me?
