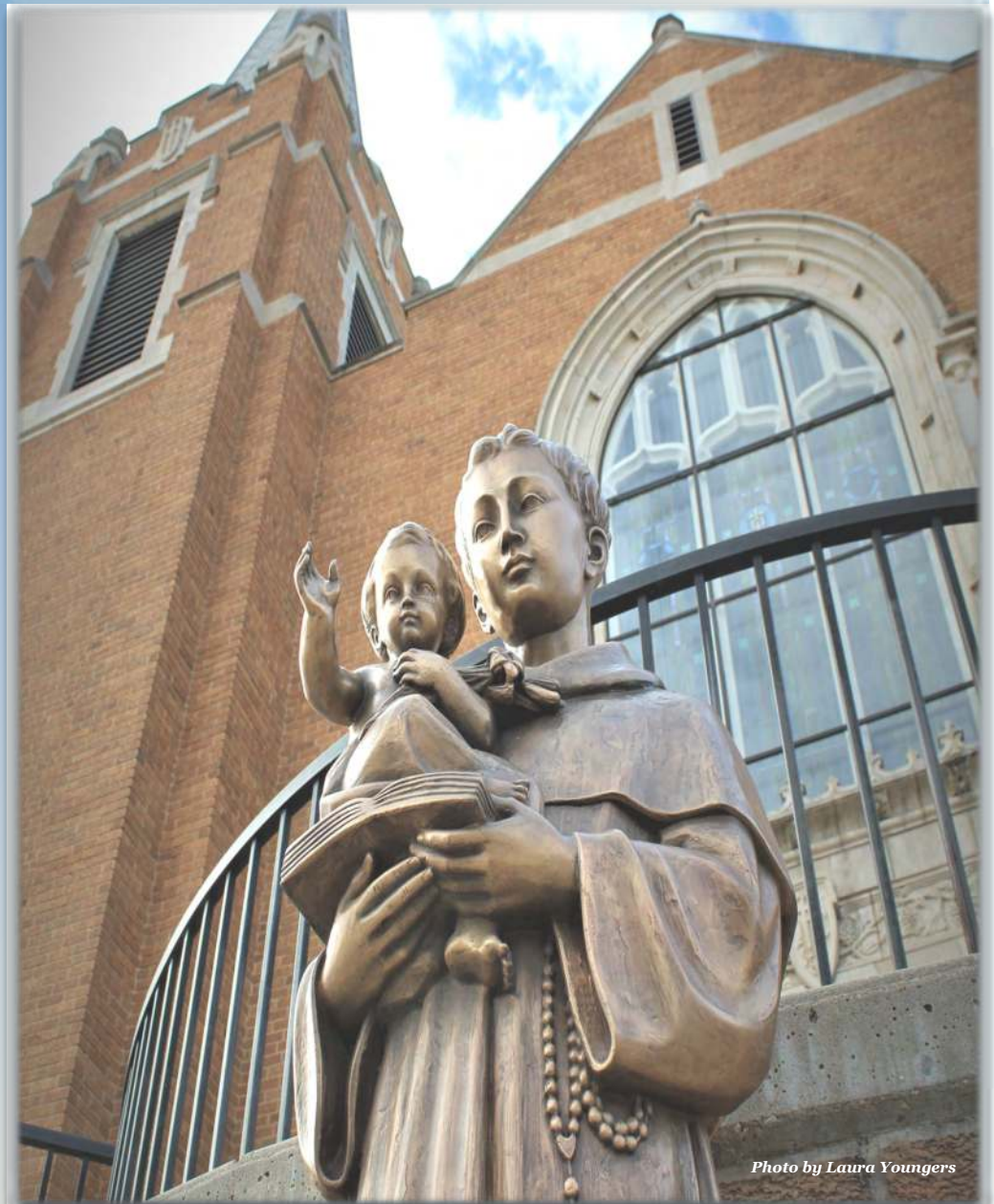

**October 23, Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time: Am 6:1a, 4-7 / Ps 146:7, 8-9, 9-10 / 1 Tm 6:11-16 / Lk 16:19-3**

Who can you most identify with in today's Gospel—the self-glorified Pharisee or the humble, repenting tax collector? Are you an exemplar Catholic on the outside, but on the inside, not so much? Or maybe you are "Uber Catholic"! Is that a bad thing? Only God knows for sure. If the stewardship way of life is easy and comfortable, step it up a notch!
