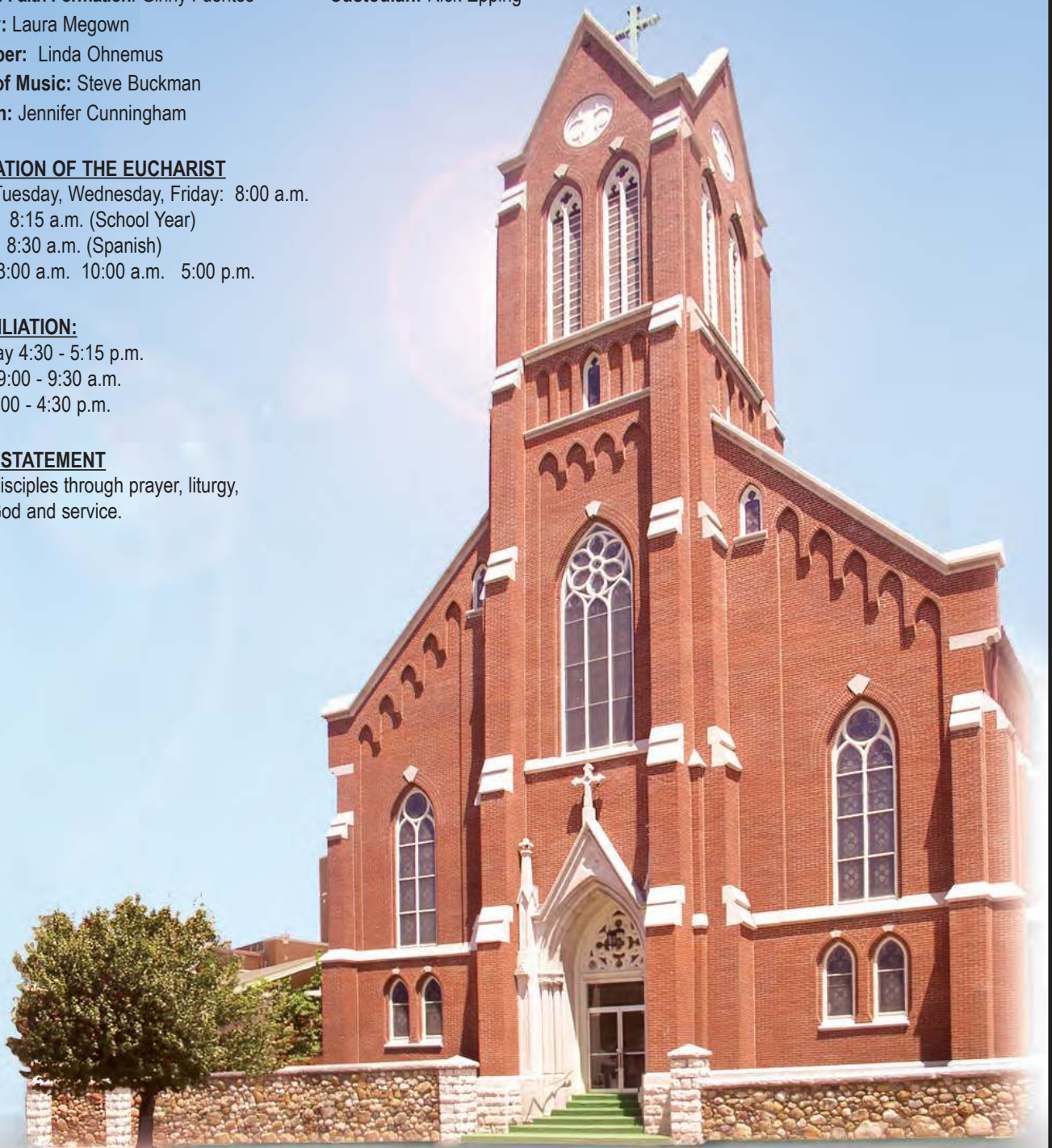

## St. Cecilia Feast Day Celebration | Nov. 29

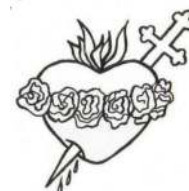

## First Saturday Devotion | Nov. 5

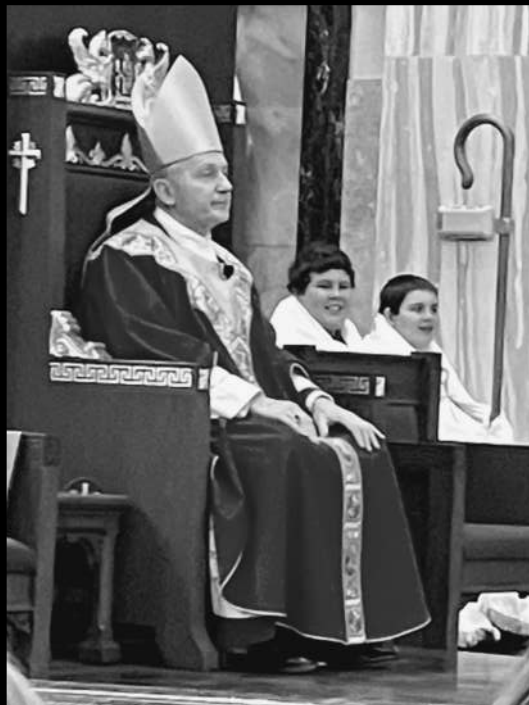
