

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 32nd Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel today Jesus deals with a question about the resurrection of the dead. Jesus says of those called, "(They) neither marry nor are given in marriage." Our faith teaches us that there is only one marriage in eternal life. That is the marriage between Christ and His People. The sacramental marriages we live today are meant to help prepare us for the eternal marriage that is to come. We pray that our marriages continue to grow in holiness, in anticipation for the eternal marriage that is Heaven.

We have the results of our **2022 October Count**. According to our numbers we had an average weekend Mass attendance of **521** *persons*, which is an **increase of +30.3%** from our 2021 October Count of 400. I believe our results are slightly inflated since some of our members have been attending Mass twice a weekend, participating in the count for "Vote with your Feet." November is Diabetes Awareness Month

Diabetes is a disease that results in too much sugar in the blood. 30 million people in the US have some form of this disease. 1 in 4 don't realize they're walking around with it. It is the 7th leading cause of death in the US and is the number one cause of kidney failure, lower limb amputations, and adult blindness.

Types of diabetes include:

- Type 1 Diabetes chronic condition in which the pancreas produces little to no insulin
- Type 2 Diabetes chronic condition that affects the way the body processes sugar in the blood
- Prediabetes a condition in which the blood sugar is high, but not high enough to be considered type 2.
- Gestational Diabetes—develops in some pregnant woman regardless of previous diabetes status

The most common symptoms of Diabetes are:

- Increased thirst
- . Increased urination
- Fatigue
- Weight loss

Eating too much sugar does not cause diabetes, however being overweight can predispose you to developing the disease.

There is no cure for diabetes but it can be managed. Losing weight, eating healthy food and being active can help.


