

Stewardship Renewal - Our deadline to return completed Stewardship Renewal forms has passed as we are now getting all of our information put into our parish data system. Our goal was to get everything updated in the data system by the end of December in order to have accurate and current information with respect to our ministries, organizations, etc. to begin the new calendar year. Sadly, I must report to you that of the 430 registered families we have here, only 164 time and talent forms were returned, and only 160 treasure forms were returned. I had honestly hoped that we would see a much more successful return rate. While I am saddened by such a small return, I am hopeful and optimistic that many of you have just overlooked getting these back to the parish office and will do so as soon as possible.

It is most important that we realize that our parish family is just that, a family. A family that needs everyone to be active and committed to making our parish as vibrant and successful as possible, no matter who we are. We are all important, we are all needed, and we all matter. If you haven't done so, I would kindly ask that you take the few minutes it takes and complete your renewal materials and return them as soon as possible.
