Second Sunday after Epiphany

FROM THE RECTOR

On this Second Sunday after Epiphany, we are presented with The Wedding Feast of Cana, the first of the Lord's miracles. We are afforded the opportunity to contemplate this miraculous occurrence as we continue to rest comfortably in the mystery of the Incarnation. In both instances, our Blessed Mother plays a unique and central role to the unfolding of the realities around Her: She is the mediatrix prompting our Lord to make manifest His glory and She is the worthy tabernacle of the Word Made Flesh. In both of these instances, She is the first apostle testifying to the joys of Our Savior. Our Lord performs this first of His many miracles in order to make manifest His glory and to confirm the faith of His disciples. This may also be said of the Incarnation – the Savior takes flesh to manifest His glory and the glory of the Father as well as to strengthen and confirm the faith of all who choose to believe in Him. In the final analysis this is what is required of us: to believe in the power and glory, might and majesty of Our Savior and then to go forth and witness to the truth of Christ to the ends of the world!
