From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel we hear the story of Jesus' calling of his first disciples: Peter, Andrew, James, and John. "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." The disciples' response was immediate. "At once they left their nets and followed him." For most of us, our response to Jesus' call is a little more slow and gradual. It sometimes takes time, maturity, and self-knowledge to deepen our discipleship in following Jesus Christ.

This weekend the Universal Church celebrates the "Sunday of the Word of God." The Church celebrates the importance of the Sacred Scriptures in our everyday lives of faith. Blessed Sacrament Parish will celebrate this day by gifting our 8th Grade students with brand new Bibles of their own from the Great Adventure Catholic Bible series. I would like to express my gratitude to the many parish members who each donated \$36 for each of our 8th Grade students to receive this Bible. Thank you all for helping give our students a beautiful keepsake for their journeys of faith.

Over the next four weeks I will be leading a **4-Part Teaching Series on the Mass.** Last weekend, we talked about the Introductory Rites. This weekend we will discuss the "Liturgy of the Word." The next two weekends we will cover: "The Preparation Rites" (Jan. 28-29) and "Liturgy of the Eucharist" (Feb. 4-5).

In order to help support the increasing disbursements by the growing mission of our parish St. Vincent De Paul Society, I have recommended that our parish take up a quarterly 2nd collection on the 5th Sundays of the month. We will take up our first 5th Sunday collection on the weekend of Jan. 28-29. This weekend our St. Vincent de Paul members will speak before Masses to give a little explanation for this need.

Our parish will have a **Brown Scapular Enrollment on Sat. Feb. 4 at our monthly 8:30 a.m. 1st Saturday Mass.** In order to explain more about the Brown Scapular, Kathy Obert of our Legion of Mary Presidium will be present after Masses next weekend to give a little background on this Marian devotion.

Next Sunday marks the beginning of **Catholic Schools Week** (Jan. 29 – Feb. 3). We will kick-off the week with Sunday 10 a.m. Mass next Sun. Jan. 29. Many events will be planned throughout the week. I invite you to share in our excitement of celebrating Catholic education here at Blessed Sacrament in Quincy.

Our Accounting Office is making available **Printed copies of your annual 2022 Financial contribution statements** for you to pick up in church. Next weekend (Jan. 28/29) we will have labeled and sealed envelopes containing your contribution information that you can use in preparing your tax return. Envelopes will be sorted alphabetically, and we encourage you to pick up your sealed envelope before or after Mass.

We have begun celebrating an 11:10 a.m. Spanish Mass. We have made bilingual missalettes available which allow both English and Spanish speaking members to follow along in the Mass. Please feel free to attend this Sunday Spanish Mass at any time.

Finally, today would have marked the 50th Anniversary of Roe v. Wade. This was the Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion in our country. Although Roe v. Wade is no longer "the law of the land," we continue to pray for the end of abortion in our nation. We pray for the many victims of abortion: the unborn, and also the mothers and fathers who seek healing, love, and forgiveness from our Lord Jesus.




