

Today we celebrate the **4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel as the beginning of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount, we hear His Eight Beatitudes. We pray that in our own lives, the Beatitudes might come alive by our everyday lives.

This weekend marks the beginning of **Catholic Schools Week** (Jan. 29 – Feb. 3). We will kick-off the week with Sunday Masses next Sun. January 31. Many events are planned throughout the week. I invite you to share in our excitement of celebrating Catholic education here at Blessed Sacrament in Quincy.

This week is Part 3 of our **4-Part Teaching Series on the Mass**. Last weekend, we talked about the Introductory Rites. This weekend we will discuss the "Preparation Rites." Next weekend we will cover: "Liturgy of the Eucharist."

In order to help support the increasing disbursements by the growing mission of our parish St. Vincent DePaul Society, I have recommended that our parish take up a quarterly 2<sup>nd</sup> collection on the **5<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month**. This weekend we are taking up our first 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday collection immediately after Holy Communion. Thank you for your support of those in need in our Quincy community.

Our parish will have a **Brown Scapular Conferral next Sat. February 4 at our monthly 8:30 a.m. 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday Mass**. In order to explain more about the Brown Scapular, Kathy Obert of our Legion of Mary Presidium will be present after Masses this weekend to give a little background on this Marian devotion.

Next Sun. Feb. 5 at the 10:00 a.m. Mass we will celebrate **Boy Scout Sunday**. The Cub and Boy Scouts of Blessed Sacrament Parish will be leading the many different ministries within the Mass. We will also have a number of religious medals which we will be giving to our Scouts. We have great gratitude for the presence of our Cub and Boy Scout troupes here at Blessed Sacrament.




