

Looking ahead. As a rule, Fr. Tony makes use of one week in October for retreat (already done!) and a week in February, just to get away for a while. Fr. Tony will be gone for one week, from Sunday afternoon, February 5, to Saturday afternoon, February 12. A schedule for the week in his absence will be forthcoming. Deacons Dan Moffitt and Tony Herdrich will be leading a series of talks on the Holy Eucharist, with periods of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Fr. Paul will offer the Sacrifice of the Mass a few times during the week; our deacons will lead a Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion throughout the week at other usually scheduled Mass times. Please take advantage of what our deacons and their expanded ministry have to offer us, and take advantage of these opportunities to deepen faith and love in the mystery of the Holy Eucharist.
