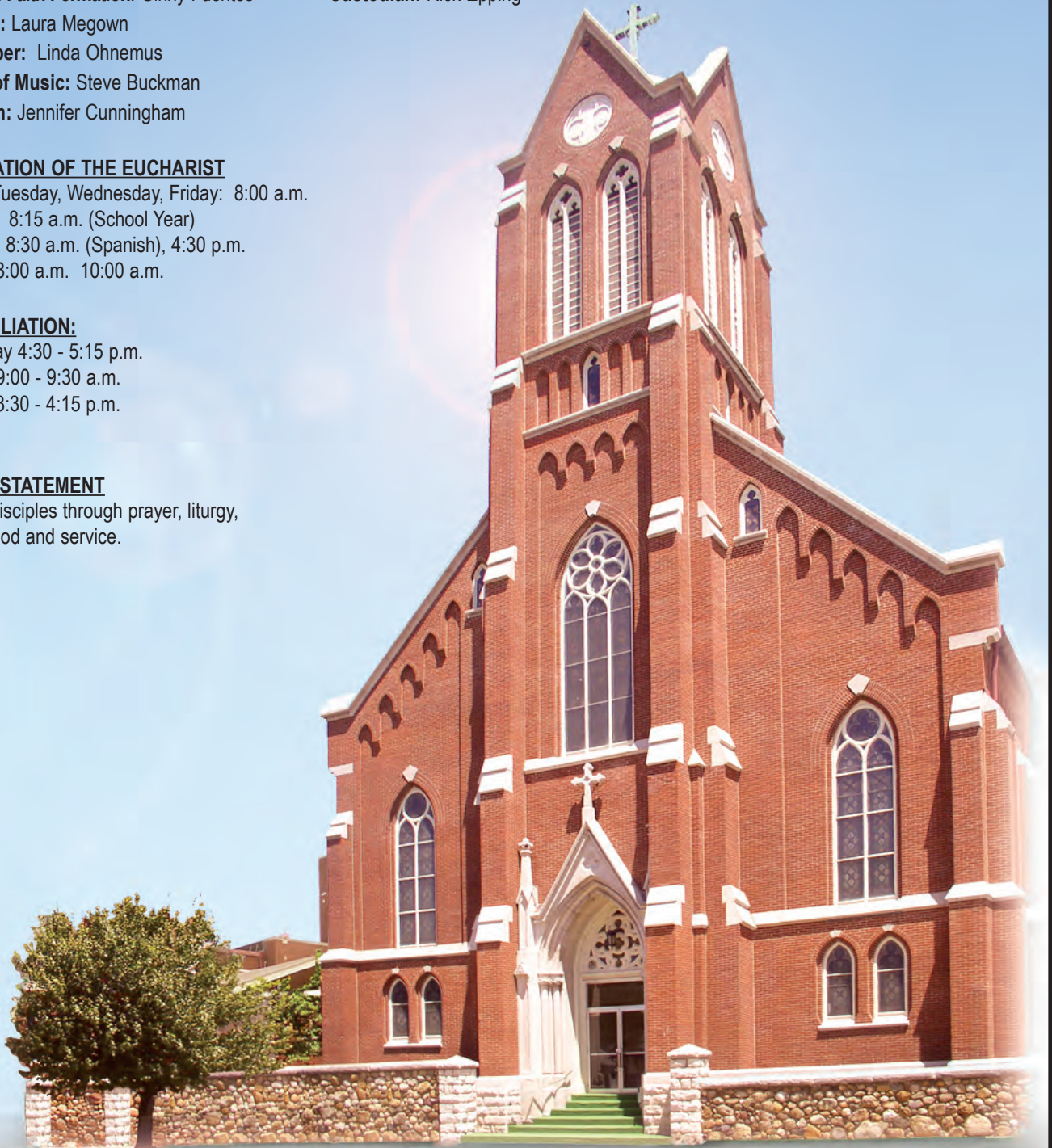

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 7th **Sunday of Ordinary Time**. "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you." The Gospel continues Jesus' moral teachings from Matthew's Sermon on the Mount. One of our greatest acts of love is simply to agree to *begin* the journey of forgiveness of those who have hurt us. Personal offenses can take a long time to heal. Simply beginning the journey of healing is a great act of love.

This upcoming Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent as we celebrate **Ash Wednesday**. Our Ash Wednesday liturgies will be celebrated at the following three times:

8:15 a.m. Mass
4:00 p.m. Spanish Mass
5:30 p.m. Mass

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting -giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity – doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity. Blessed Sacrament will provide several liturgical and devotional opportunities each week during Lent to assist you in your spiritual growth during this Lenten season.

5:30 p.m.: Mass

5:30 p.m.: Passion Meditation on the Gospel of Matthew (Church)
6:00 p.m.: Stations of the Cross (Church)

The following are the **Lenten regulations** for Catholics to observe.
Abstinence – Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Friday's of Lent.

Fast – Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Only one full meatless meal, and two much smaller meatless meals, are permitted. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

Last weekend our parish is took up a 2nd **Collection for the Family of Sage Moore**. Sage was a 3rd Grade student from Blessed Sacrament School who was called home by our Lord this past December. If you have not yet had the opportunity to make a donation, please make any checks you give payable to "Blessed Sacrament," with "Family of Sage Moore" in the memo.

This Sunday at 2:00 p.m. we celebrate 1st **Reconciliation for all of our 2nd Grade students**. Please pray for our 2nd Grade students that they might have a wonderful first encounter with the power of God's mercy in their lives.

This Sunday at our 10:00 a.m. Mass I will **Commission our New 4th Grade Altar Servers**. We thank them for saying "yes" to this important liturgical ministry at Blessed Sacrament Parish.

On Friday's at 5:30-6:00 p.m. in the upcoming Season of Lent, I will be presenting a **6-part weekly Lenten Meditations on the "Passion according to St. Matthew."** This is something I enjoyed doing annually at a former parish, and I'd like to share with our members of Blessed Sacrament. Each weekly meditation is only 30 minutes long. I hope it might be a nice way to prepare for the Passion Reading that we will hear this upcoming Palm Sunday. Our Friday evening Lenten schedule will therefore look like this:

During this upcoming season of Lent we will celebrate a **40 Hours Devotion on the weekend of March 17-19**. This devotion consists in 40 straight hours of Eucharistic Adoration, marking the 40 hours that Jesus spent in the tomb. For these 40 hours we are asking for parish members to sign up for one hour of Eucharistic Adoration from Friday 4:00 p.m. through Sunday 8:00 a.m. We will have several ways for parish members to sign up: online (Sign-up Genius) or on paper. Please consider offering one hour during this time as part of your upcoming Lenten offering.

Finally, during the Season of Lent (Feb. 22 – Apr. 2), **40 Days for Life** is inviting parish members to sign up for a one-hour time slot to pray in front of our local Walgreen's in order to witness the sanctity of all human life. This weekend, Colleen Maalouf of our parish will tell us about this local Quincy Pro Life initiative before each of our weekend Masses. Please consider signing up for a time slot. Our own Blessed Sacrament Parish is committing our peaceful presence on **Wednesday's from 9 a.m.-5 p.m.** throughout these 40 days.

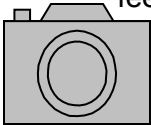

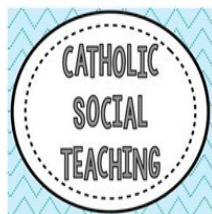

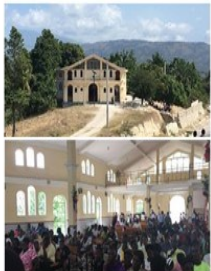
