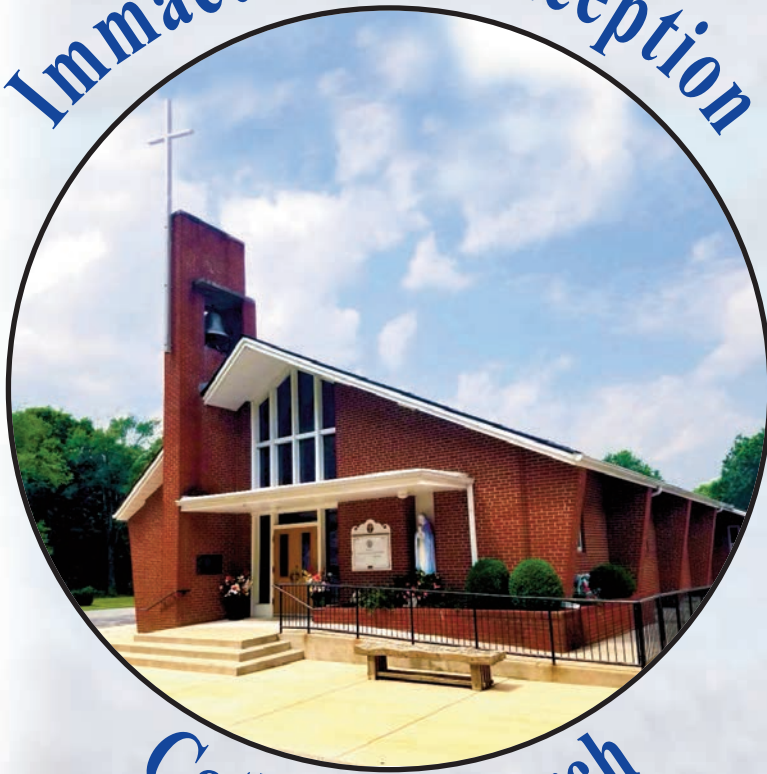

### WHEN DO WE DO THIS?

**Fast & Abstain:** Ash Wednesday & Good Friday  
**Abstain:** All Fridays during Lent

### WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

**Fasting:** Eating one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.  
**Abstinence:** Refraining from eating meat

### WHO NEEDS TO FAST & ABSTAIN?

**Fast:** Ages 18-59  
**Abstain:** 14 and older
