Today we celebrate the 5^{th} Sunday of Ordinary Time. In the gospel Jesus tells his disciples, "You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world." What an amazing compliment Jesus is giving to all of us! Despite our sin and self-centeredness Jesus thinks *that* highly of us. And Jesus does not want us to hide the "gift" of ourselves. He encourages us to allow their gifts and talents to shine... all for the glory of God.

This Sun. Feb. 5 at the 10:00 a.m. Mass we will celebrate **Boy Scout Sunday**. The Cub and Boy Scouts of Blessed Sacrament Parish will be leading the many different ministries within the Mass. We will also have a number of religious medals which we will be giving to our Scouts. I have great gratitude for the presence of our Cub and Boy Scout troups here at Blessed Sacrament. Youth Bible Study 6th - 8th Grade Thursdays in February & March 3:15 PM




