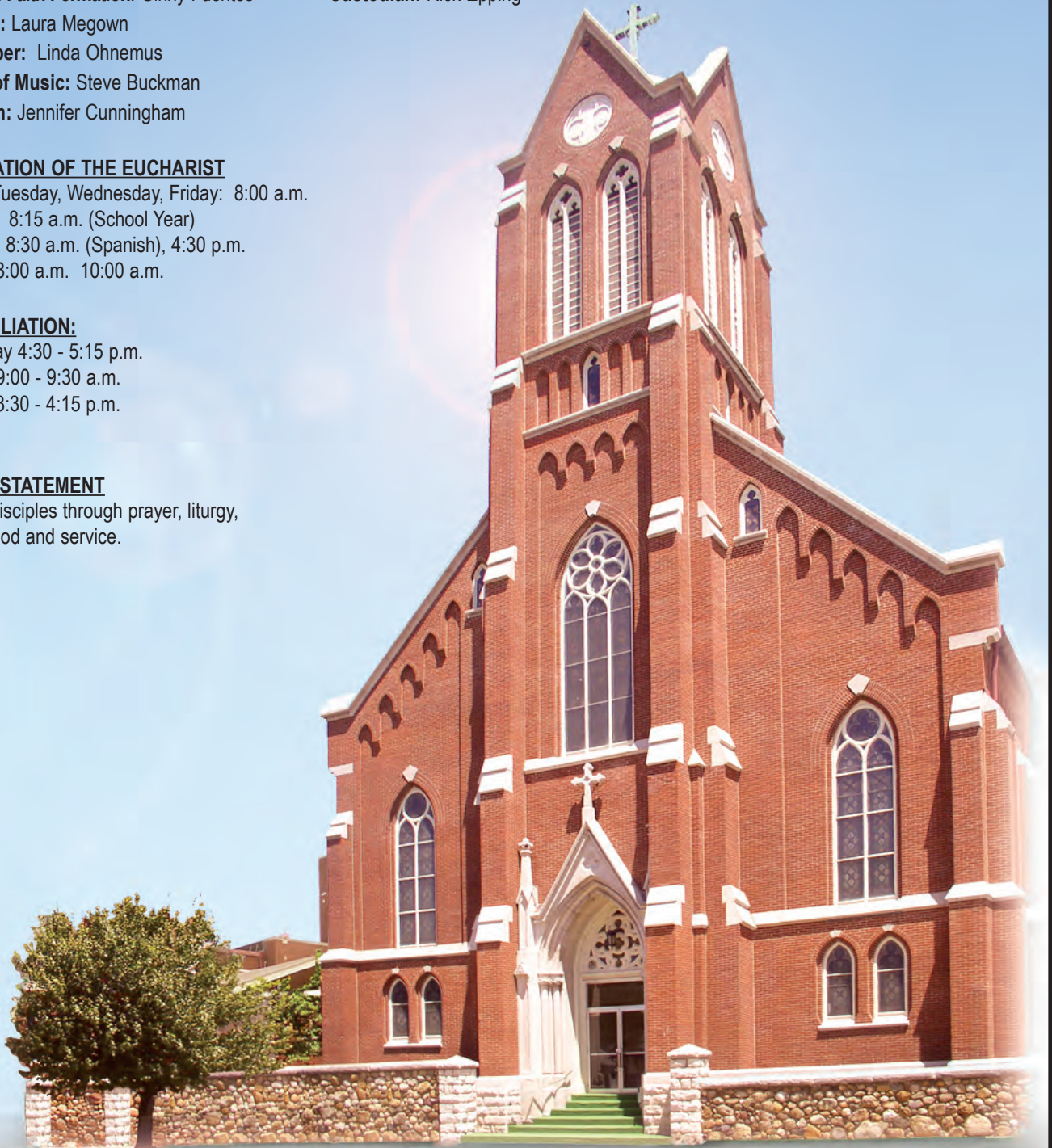

Today we celebrate the **4th Sunday of Lent**. In the gospel we hear the story of Jesus' Healing of the Man Born Blind. Jesus asks the newly healed man born blind, "Do you believe in the Son of Man?" The man replies, "Who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?" Jesus responds, "You have *seen* him, and the one speaking with you is he." The blind man sees with his newly restored eyes. But more importantly he sees Jesus with the eyes of faith. "I do believe, Lord." May this Lent be a graced time of renewing our faith in our Lord Jesus.

In two weeks (Saturday April 1) we will celebrate the **Sacraments of Confirmation/1st Communion for our 3rd Grade Students** at the Springfield Cathedral. Bishop Thomas Paprocki will celebrate these sacraments for our students along with children attending from parishes in Brussels, Collinsville, and Hardin. Please place our students in your prayers the next two weeks in anticipation of these sacraments which will complete their initiation in the Catholic Church.

There will be one **"City Wide" Lenten Penance Service** for Quincy area Catholics to attend. Many priests will be available to hear confessions.

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting -giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity - doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity. Blessed Sacrament will provide several liturgical and devotional opportunities each week during Lent to assist you in your spiritual growth during this Lenten season.

Following Mass, there will be a rally and march at the Illinois State Capitol. With the fall of Roe v. Wade last June, the legislative battle on abortion has moved to the state level. We here in Illinois have an important opportunity to express to our elected representatives our belief in the sanctity of all human life.
