4th Sunday of Lent 19 March 2023

FROM THE RECTOR

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is traditionally called Laetare Sunday taking its name from the opening words of the Introit: Rejoice, O Jerusalem! Our joy is exhorted not only because our Lenten pilgrimage has considerably advanced but also and more importantly because we are yet again reminded of the power of Christ's salvific work on the Cross. The Church reminds us through the sacred liturgy and the Divine Office of the work of our Heavenly Father with His Chosen people: setting them free from slavery in Egypt; feeding them with manna; giving them the Law on Mount Sinai on their sojourn to the Promised Land. Moses is God's prophet, but in Christ we have Moses fulfilled. And the work of Christ frees us from the slavery to sin, feeds us with His own Body and delivers us to the new Jerusalem in Heaven. These are all reasons to rejoice and give thanks to God. The uncertainties of the world and the Church call us to trust in the Lord and the fulfillment of His promises which is given to us each time we celebrate the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Continue your Lenten journey with diligence and joy. Now, more than ever, do not waver or stumble carrying your cross. The age in which we live is, at times, truly difficult for us all but it also provides us the opportunity to configure ourselves to Christ crucified. And for that opportunity, let us rejoice in the Lord!


