

1 Sm 16:1b, 6-7, 10-13a / Ps 23:1-3a, 3b-4, 5,6 / Eph 5:8-14 / Jn 9:1-41

God chose David, the youngest of eight brothers, to be his anointed, his king. We can imagine there may have been some animosity among the brothers. They probably couldn't believe their eyes! 
