Jesus speaks to Martha just before this great miracle, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live." The Paschal Mystery of dying and rising surrounds our lives. Crosses, burdens, and suffering fill our lives; yet we also experience new life and new joys. Dying and rising is "Life". When accompanied by faith, this dying and rising leads us deeper into the Mystery of Christ.

Next Saturday April 1 we will celebrate the **Sacraments of Confirmation/1st Communion for our 3rd Grade Students** at the Springfield Cathedral. Bishop Thomas Paprocki will celebrate these sacraments for our students along with children attending from parishes in Brussels, Collinsville, and Hardin.
