Passion Sunday 26 March 2023

FROM THE RECTOR

One of the great sources of spiritual richness is the structure of the liturgical calendar and how it assists us in not only celebrating the Paschal Mystery but forces us to penetrate more deeply into these mysteries. This dynamic is manifest in our celebration today of Passion Sunday. In the new calendar, Passion Sunday and Palm Sunday are collapsed into one reality which is an unfortunate occurrence precisely because entrance into the Lord's Passion and Death requires not only recalling His triumphal entrance into Jerusalem (Palm Sunday) but also meditating on the hardness of heart, hatred of truth, and rejection of God that was swirling around Our Lord before and during His entrance into the Holy City. Passion Sunday inserts us into the events surrounding our Lord, leading to His Passion and Death. This profound meditation on these Sacred Mysteries forces us to acknowledge our own sins and their contribution to the Lord's suffering. The veiled images we encounter in Church today, which will remain until the joyous proclamation of Easter, serve as liturgical reminders for us to strive to find the Lord at all times especially when He might be obscured by our doubts, fears, and sins. Let us entreat the Holy Spirit to provide us with strength and courage to die with Christ in order that we might truly live with Him!
