Today we celebrate the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Lent. In the gospel we hear the story of the Transfiguration. Jesus is transformed before his disciples in order to strengthen them for the challenging journey ahead. This is a journey that will lead to the cross on Calvary. We ask the Lord this Sunday for his continued strengthening during our own Lenten journey of repentance and transformation...a journey that too has its own cross.

This weekend Quincy Notre Dame kicks off their Annual Fund with a talk at all Masses by current QND students. As a QND alumnus, I can personally attest to the value of a QND education. I ask that parish members listen with your hearts this week to the testimony provided by our QND students. We hope that we all might respond generously to the QND Annual Fund Drive.
