**SANCTUARY CANDLE DEDICATION:
CHRIST IS THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD**

Candles are used in worship as a reminder of Christ our light and the light in us that is His grace. They are also a symbol of His sacrifice. As the candle burns, it sacrifices itself in order to give light. When we light a candle, we make an offering for a particular intention. The candles that burn before the Blessed Sacrament in red globes are offerings to God for particular intentions. We have 2 week candles that costs \$20 and 1 week that cost \$10. Candle offering envelopes can be found in the votive candle stands.

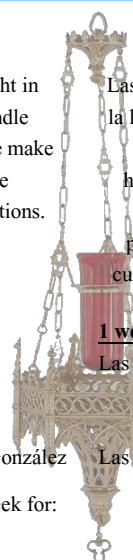

An Attitude of Gratitude

Frank T. Masur, Ph.D., Clinical & Health Psychologist

Join us May 3 for a Seminar with Dr. Masur! In this 90 minute Seminar, combining didactic training with experiential learning, Dr. Masur will review and critique the burgeoning research that convincingly demonstrates that daily expressions of “thankfulness” have remarkably positive effects across a wide spectrum of human experience. Over a thousand published studies have now shown that daily journaling about the people and things that we are grateful for has a consistently positive effect on our physical, emotional, social, and even spiritual lives. The biopsychosocial mechanisms by which these results have been demonstrated include increased optimism, reduced depression, increased stress tolerance and the enhancement of the body’s immunologic processes. Summarizing these research findings into a Cognitive-Behavioral approach to expressing genuine gratitude will form the basis of a practical guide that participants will be able to use on a daily basis.

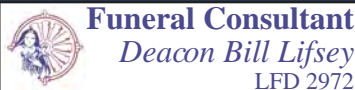
