



## What To Fill Your Anxiety 'Toolbox' With

Put physical items in your coping toolbox that will help soothe your five senses. Here are some examples of objects to use to engage each sense:

**Smells...**Choose items that have scents that are pleasing to you. Lavender scented items, a favorite perfume, lotion, candles, vanilla, cinnamon, essential oils or chocolate.

**Sounds**...Create a playlist of songs that evoke calming or pleasing memories. Be sure to include head-phones, chimes or a rainstick.

**Touch**...Choose items you can hold or rub in your hands or even on your body that are soothing or calming to you. A smooth rock, silly putty, a stress ball, a massage roller, textured cloth, a fluffy animal or a weighted blanket.

**Taste**...Pick items that are pleasing to your taste buds that are nonperishable. Hard candies, butterscotch, gum, or chocolate.

**Sight...**.These are visually appealing items. Photographs of loved ones, pets, or places you have been to in the past (this could be a small photobook), postcards from memorable trips, images of a dream location, a sand garden, coloring books, or mandalas.
