



#### ANXIETY IN CHILDREN

Anxiety may present as fear or worry often related to family, school, friends or activities and can also make children irritable and angry. Other symptoms that are seen in anxious children are behavioral changes, moodiness, aggression, temper tantrums, clinginess, frequent crying spells, fear of the dark, fear of being away from home or interacting with peers. Other symptoms are worrying about things before they happen, having low confidence and self-esteem. Some physical symptoms are stomachache, headache and/or muscle aches.

Some children are more likely to develop anxiety when they experience trauma or stress when they are maltreated, when they are bullied or rejected by other children, or when their own parents have anxiety.

Resources are available to help children manage their thoughts and behaviors. Starting with their primary care provider, seeing a counselor, talking to their school counselor or taking medication for anxiety.

Children can develop their mental health "toolbox" to manage their anxiety. The following are ideas of what a child could put in their anxiety "toolbox": coloring books with crayons or markers, music, favorite stuffed animal, stress catcher (National Institute of Mental Health), and a worry box (put their worry in the worry box and when they start worrying again remind themselves that the box is taking care of worrying.)
