

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 5th Sunday of Easter. "In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If there were not, would I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you?" During this season of Easter we meditate on how we have received a share in Christ's resurrection. One day we hope to share fully in that resurrection in Heaven, "the Father's house". Yet our dwelling in that *house* does not begin when we enter Heaven. Our dwelling begins today, in our communion with the person of Jesus Christ. My life in the "Father's house" has already begun.

This Saturday/Sunday May 6-7 we are offering the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick at all Masses. We last offered this sacrament in November, so it is a good time to offer this sacrament again after six months.

Next Saturday May 13 from 8-9 a.m., we will host a Eucharistic Holy Hour to Pray for Vocations. During this Holy Hour we will have special readings and prayers in which we will offer particular intercessions for the Lord to call forth those He is inviting to the vocations of priesthood and consecrated life. Please consider sharing one hour of your Saturday morning to pray to the Lord for Vocations.

On Sunday May 21 at 10:00 a.m. Mass we will honor all **Parish Graduating H.S. Seniors from the Class of 2023.** A small reception will be held for them in the Gathering Space following our 10:00 a.m. liturgy. Congratulations to our Graduating Senior Class of 2023!

On Saturday evening May 27 at the 4:30 p.m. Mass we will celebrate the **Extended Form of the Pentecost Vigil**. The Extended Form gives us the opportunity to "pray in vigil" for the coming of the Holy Spirit, much as Mary and the Apostles did at the original Pentecost.


