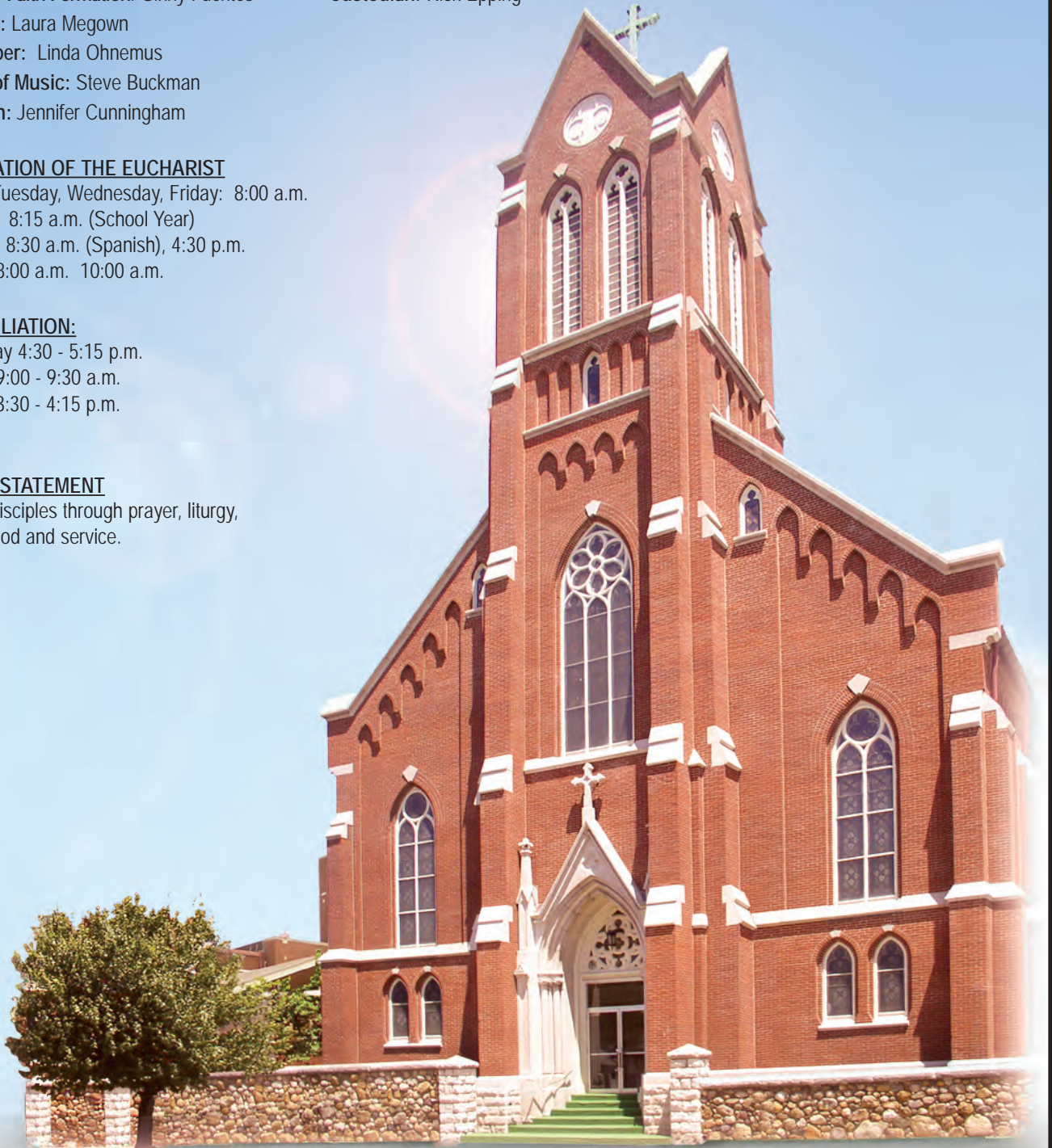

The Pilgrim Virgin Statue Church to Home Visitation



The Pilgrim Virgin statue travels from the parish church to the home of a parishioner following the Holy Mass with the purpose of bringing about the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the home. The mission of the Pilgrim Virgin statue is then completed by returning with the family to the Mass on the following week. Simply put, Our Lady always seeks to bring us to her Son.

When the Pilgrim Virgin statue enters the home for the week, it is recommended that one follow the format in the accompanying book. If possible, the family is encouraged to pray the Rosary daily. During the week, one is free to make use of the various materials that may be found in the carrying case that accompany the Pilgrim Virgin statue.

With the weather getting warmer, the risk of heat exhaustion and heat stroke increase dramatically and can be very dangerous!

Recognizing heat injury:

- excessive sweating or no sweating when out in the heat
- Dizziness or fainting
- High body temperature, above 103
- Muscle cramps

Tips for avoiding heat injury!

- Avoid being in direct sunlight during the hottest part of the day between 10am-2pm
- Stay hydrated! Drink at least 1 L of water every hour you are out in the sun, and at least half your body weight in ounces in addition to that throughout the whole day.
- Stop for frequent breaks!

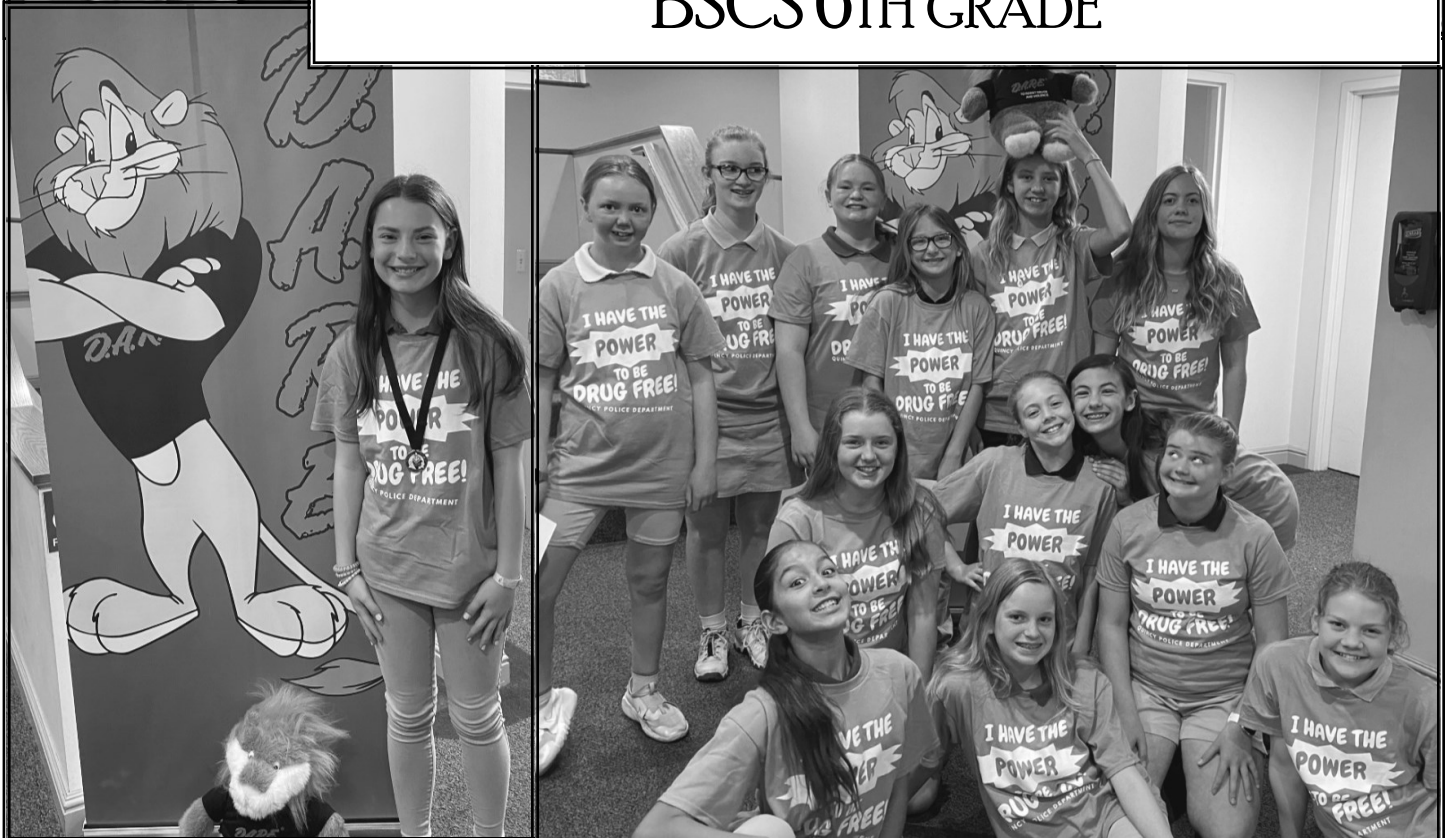

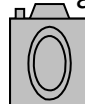

Procession to Venerable Augustine Tolton's Grave

This year's annual Pilgrimage Procession to the grave of the Venerable Servant of God Father Augustine Tolton, the first publicly-recognized Black priest in the USA, will take place on July 9, the 126th anniversary of his death.

The pilgrimage procession will leave from the statue of Father Tolton outside St. Peter's church in Quincy at 4:00 p.m. and walk to his grave, about a mile away, for the praying of Evening Prayer at 4:30 p.m. Those who cannot participate in the walk may meet the procession at the cemetery.

Due to lack of space, no one should park in the cemetery itself. Chairs and bottled water will be provided at the cemetery.
