

From the Pastor's Desk

Today we celebrate the 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Our liturgy for the Sundays of Ordinary Time returns to the Gospel of Matthew. In today's Gospel Jesus sees a large crowd of people, and his heart is moved "because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd."

Jesus calls forth his Twelve Apostles by name, and gave them the following divine power:

Authority over unclean spirits to drive them out; Authority to cure every disease and illness.

Jesus then specifies that they are not to go to Gentile or Samaritan towns. Rather they are to go to "the lost sheep of the house of Israel." There they will make the proclamation, "The kingdom of heaven is at hand."

Jesus gives one final motivation to His Apostles. "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." As modern day disciples it would be a marvelous thing to have Jesus' divine power to cast out spirits and to cure the sick. I would imagine that it would be a bit thrilling to try out this divine power on people we know who are hurting. We wouldn't need motivation if that authority were at our fingertips.

Yet!.... as a royal priesthood in Jesus Christ, we do have authority to intercede and bring forth God's mighty deeds among us. The Kingdom of heaven is still at hand! Ask the Lord how He wishes for you to exercise your divinely received authority on behalf of the good of others. Christ's sheep are troubled and waiting for you!






