The previous 2 parishes I served at moved their 5:00 mass to 4:00 some time after I had already left—St. James, Glen Ellyn and St. Ann, Channahon. I brought this subject up at last week's Parish Advisory Council meeting for discussion.

What I'm hearing is, the earlier time stays away from the traditional "dinner hour", and gives daylight to all—for vision, safety, easier access. In light of our recent events, I am also seeing people doing things earlier than they used to, when it is available. For example, our Friday night charismatic prayer group used to meet at 7:00 p.m. They now meet on Friday at 2:00 in the afternoon.


