FROM THE RECTOR

Today's celebration of the Holy Sacrifice exhorts us to have faith and confidence in the Divine Providence of our Savior. There are a great many sources of discouragement in the Church today: immorality among Her bishops and priests; heretical doctrines taught in the name of Christ; families devasted by divorce, sexual immorality and licentiousness; empty convents, churches, and seminaries. At the risk of being too theoretical, we must remember that the Oratory has suffered the loss of the whole school building in favor of secular forces and greed. Despite setbacks, personal and communal, we should be inspired to live even more heroically the call to holiness and the search for virtue. We are only successful if we willingly and joyfully trust in the Lord. This trust must be especially vigilant precisely in times of struggles, temptation, and sacrifice. There will always be crosses that we are asked to bear and struggles we are called to endure; however, through and with the grace of God which becomes more firm in us if we trust in Him, we are able to triumph and share in the victory that was won for us on the Cross. Let us pray for the courage and confidence to trust in the Lord at all times: let us truly leave all things and follow Him!
