





# Procession to Venerable Augustine Tolton's Grave

This year's annual Pilgrimage Procession to the grave of the Venerable Servant of God Father Augustine Tolton, the first publicly-recognized Black priest in the USA, will take place on July 9, the 126<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his death.

The pilgrimage procession will leave from the statue of Father Tolton outside St. Peter's church in Quincy at 4:00 p.m. and walk to his grave, about a mile away, for the praying of Evening Prayer at 4:30 p.m. Those who cannot participate in the walk may meet the procession at the cemetery.

Due to lack of space, no one should park in the cemetery itself. Chairs and bottled water will be provided at the cemetery.
