### BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

### MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled **AFTER** meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

### July 16, Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Is 55:10-11 / Ps 65:10, 11, 12-13, 14 / Rom 8:18-23 / Mt 13:1-23

Ever heard of heirloom seeds? Heirloom seeds are passed down from the previous season's plants—for over 50 years! Typically, the plant and fruit experienced the year before, will be the similar experience in the following years—if you save the seeds, or let them self-propagate. Hybrid seeds on the other hand, might only produce a harvest the first year and after that, who knows. The Stewardship model in our diocese began in 1985—not quite an heirloom, but it has continued to produce the kind of fruit our Lord described in today's Gospel.
