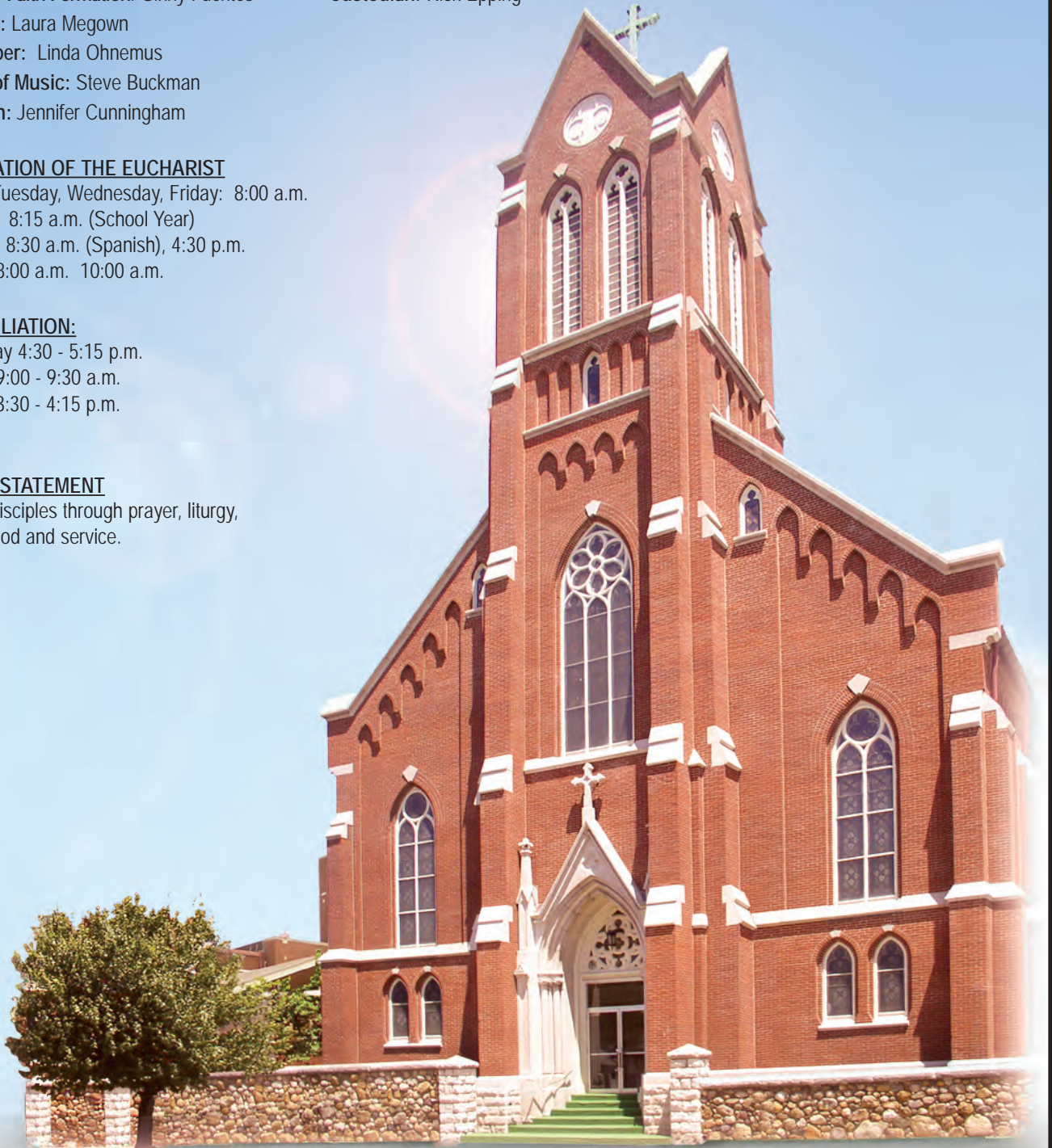

Today the Church celebrates the 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the Gospel Jesus finally finds the time He has wanted to go by himself to pray. Meanwhile the Apostles are caught out in the boat by themselves at night in a wind storm. Jesus comes to them miraculously walking on the sea. When Peter sees that it is Jesus coming to them, he wants to walk out towards Him. Peter succeeds for a moment, but then his fear overcomes him and he begins to sink. Jesus stretches out his hand to catch Peter, and the wind dies down immediately after Jesus enters the boat. Fear has such a large impact on all of our lives, even though we intuitively know that it is contrary to our faith. Jesus says over and over throughout the Gospels, "Do not be afraid." We continue to pray that Jesus' message will penetrate our fearful hearts.

I am grateful for the hard work that our new principal, Lisa Berhorst, and her fantastic teachers and staff have done this past summer in getting our classrooms and curriculums ready for our incoming students. 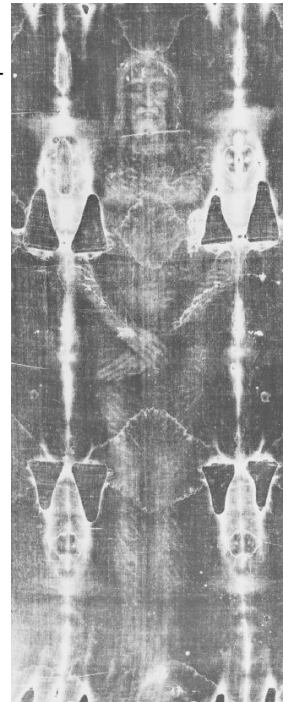

The Man of the Shroud

Exhibit coming to Vandalia –

You are invited to see a replica of the Shroud of Turin, which is believed by many to be the burial cloth of Jesus, and to learn about the history and science behind it by experiencing The Man of the Shroud Exhibit, coming to Mother of Dolors Parish in Vandalia for display September 8-14.

The Center for the Study of the Passion of the Christ and the Holy Shroud has developed a moving and informative mobile exhibit on the Shroud of Turin. The centerpiece is a full-length canvas replica of the Shroud made by the Shroud of Turin Education and Research Association, Inc. In addition, the mobile exhibit contains a large, crucified corpus showing the wounds of Christ corresponding to the passion narrative in the Gospel accounts and the wounds shown on the Shroud. The exhibit contains over 31 pop-up display banners detailing the history and science of the Shroud.

7:45 the 7th street alley entrance closes.

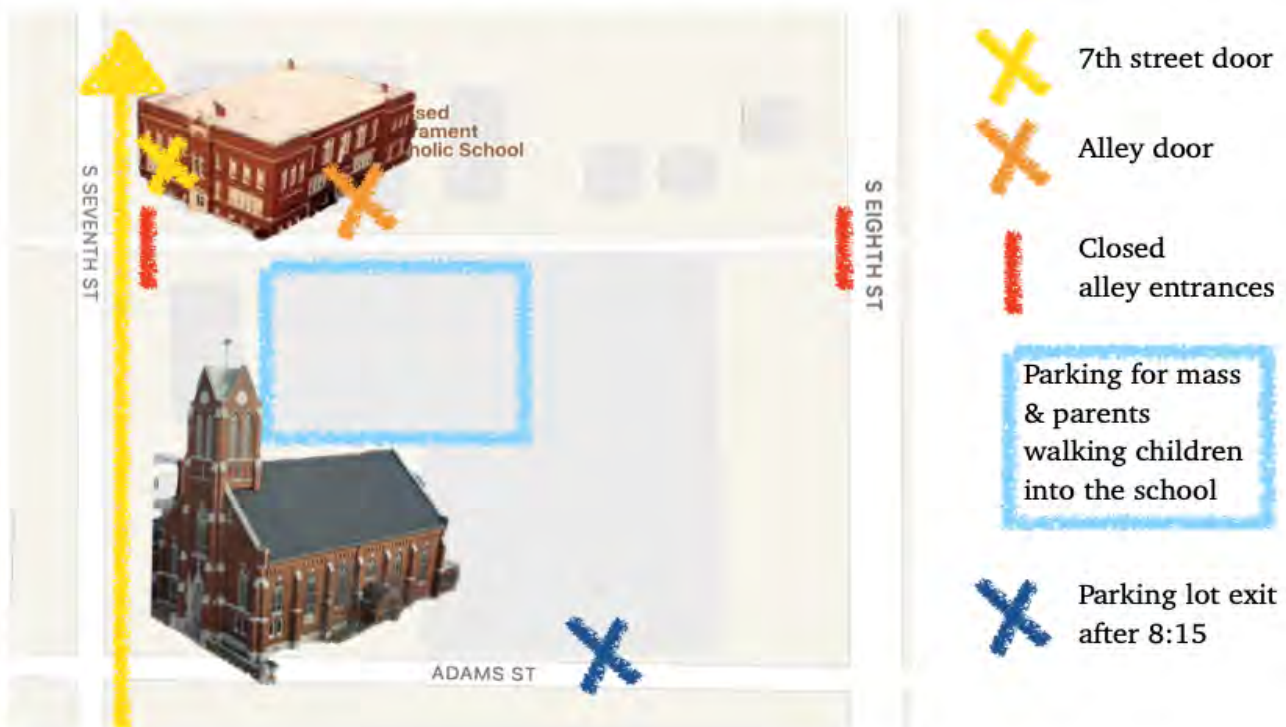
8:15 the 8th street alley entrance closes. The parking lot should be used only for those attending morning Mass or walking their children into school.

A federal law, the Comstock Act, prohibits the mailing and the receiving of abortion-inducing drugs and abortion paraphernalia.
