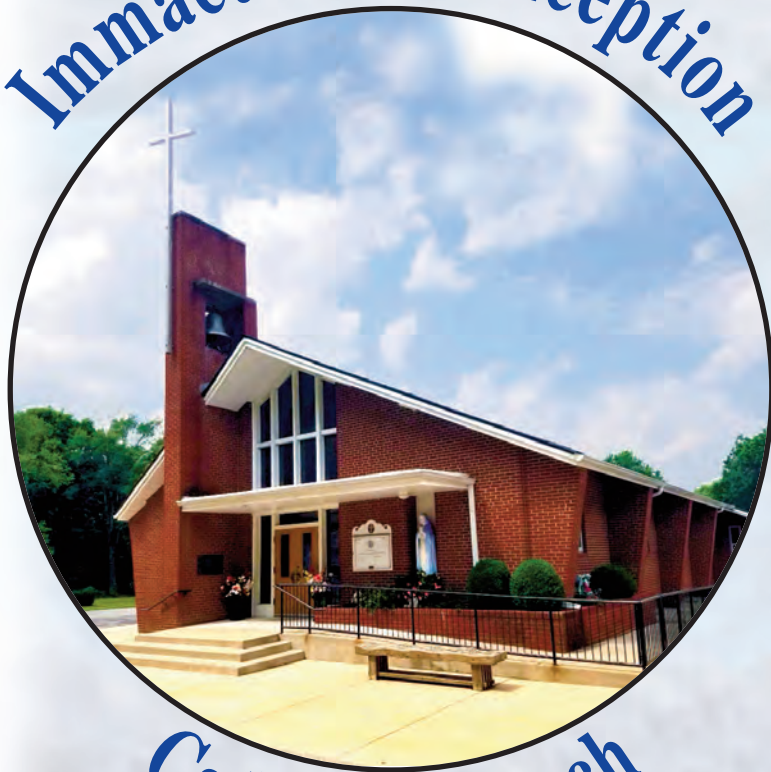

Virtus Training

The VIRTUS program was created by the National Catholic Risk Retention Group as a means of education to prevent child sexual abuse. This program meets the guidelines for safe environments as required by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and was selected by the Archbishop and his advisors as the official Safe Environment Program for the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas.

To meet the requirements of the Archdiocese of Kansas City and to ensure the safety of all children and vulnerable adults in our parish, all employees and volunteers (age 16 and older) are required to complete the Protecting God's Children for Adults training session. When you register for a training session you will complete and sign the Child Protection Policy, Code of Ethical Standards, and Harassment Policy and complete a background check. If you plan on volunteering in any position working with children and vulnerable adults you will need to attend a training session prior to volunteering.

"Protecting God's Children" will be held on **Sunday, September 10 at 6:00 p.m. in the QHR Wea parish Hall.**

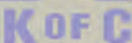
