BAPTISMS

Baptisms are celebrated after the 10:00 a.m. Mass on either the first or second Sunday of the month at St. Anthony Parish and St. Mary Parish respectively when Fr. H Setter is celebrating Mass. Parent(s) who plan to have their child baptized are required to be actively practicing their Catholic faith, be registered and active in the parish for no less than six months prior to the baptism. First time parent(s) need to attend a baptismal class. Baptismal forms are available at the parish office, during office hours. Forms need to be returned at least one week prior to the date of baptism.

MARRIAGES

The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. There is no guarantee to scheduling a wedding on your preferred day.

Annual Clergy Conference - This week, October 16 - 20, there will be no daily Masses due to the annual clergy conference in our diocese. This allows all the priests of our diocese to celebrate Mass together with our Bishop as a Presbyterate. Please keep Father Hoisington and myself and all the priests of the diocese in your prayers this week as we gather for our annual continuing education conference. Thank you.

All Souls' Day Remembrance - Please use the All Souls' Mass envelopes located at the entrances of the church to remember deceased loved ones this upcoming All Souls' Day. You can list as many names of souls you wish to remember on the envelope. Intention list will be published and kept in the sanctuary throughout the months of November and December up to Christmas. You may list as many people as you want on the envelope, but it is still only **\$10.00** per envelope and **NOT** per intention.

Weekday Masses for the Week of October 23 - While I had made provisions for Fr. Jim Mainzer to be at St. Mary Aleppo three days that week, our diocese received the unfortunate news that our brother priest Fr. Michael Schemm has been diagnosed with pancreatic cancer. Bishop Kemme has asked Fr. Mainzer to take on the responsibilities of Fr. Schemm's parish effective immediately. For that reason, Fr. Jim will not be available for coverage as we had scheduled. I will announce an altered Mass schedule for that week as soon as I have something in place, which may be quite different than what was scheduled. I greatly appreciate your understanding and flexibility with this situation. I would also ask that we all keep Fr. Michael Schemm in our daily prayers as he begins his treatment. Thank you.

Memorial Service (Mass of Remembrance) - A memorial event to remember our deceased loved ones who have died in this past year will be held on Thursday, November 15 at St. Anthony Church, followed by a reception in Franciscan Hall.
