FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In my column today, I share with you an announcement that was communicated to me by the Archdiocese.

"With deep sorrow for the suffering of victims and survivors of abuse, we share the sad news that that a former priest Robert Aiduk, has been added to the Archdiocese list of clerics who have had substantiated allegations of sexual abuse of a minor. Mr. Aiduk served in ministry at the Cathedral from August 1961 - June 1963 and the allegations investigated by the Archdiocese do not stem from his time there. Mr. Aiduk left the priesthood in September 1967, and was subsequently voluntarily laicized in 2016. This news may cause a range of emotions, and we want to assure you of the Archdiocese's commitment to all who have been harmed by an agent of the Church, to atone for the harm and to accompany survivors using restorative processes as they work toward healing and peace. The Archdiocese Substantiated Clergy Offenders listing on the website has been updated. A link can be found on the homepage of the Archdiocese at www.archkck.org.

The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas takes all allegations of misconduct by church personnel very seriously and works to respond to survivors' needs with urgency, respect, and compassion. We encourage anyone with knowledge about any misconduct by a church volunteer, employee, religious, or clergy member-- regardless of when the abuse may have occurred-- to contact civil authorities first, and then make a report to our confidential report line at (913) 647-3051 or online at www.archkck.org/reportabuse. We care about survivors of abuse. Victim Care Advocates can be reached at (913) 298-9244 or (913) 433-6701."

This is sorrowful news. Along with appropriate reporting, if anyone has any concerns or would like to speak with me, please contact me at the parish office. Let us pray for the victims of abuse by a representative of the Church, that they may find healing from these terrible crimes. Let us also remain vigilant and ensure that this never happens again.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

En mi columna de hoy, comparto con ustedes un anuncio que me comunicó la Arquidiócesis.

"Con profundo dolor por el sufrimiento de las víctimas y sobrevivientes de abuso, compartimos la triste noticia de que el ex-sacerdote Robert Aiduk ha sido agregado a la lista de clérigos de la Arquidiócesis que han tenido acusaciones fundamentadas de abuso sexual de un menor. El Sr. Aiduk sirvió en el ministerio en la Catedral desde agosto de 1961 hasta junio de 1963 y las acusaciones investigadas por la Arquidiócesis no se derivan de su estancia allí. El Sr. Aiduk dejó el sacerdocio en septiembre de 1967 y posteriormente fue laicizado voluntariamente en 2016. Esta noticia puede causar una variedad de emociones y queremos asegurarles el compromiso de la Arquidiócesis con todos los que han sido perjudicados por un agente de la Iglesia, para expiar el daño y acompañar a los sobrevivientes mediante procesos restaurativos mientras trabajan hacia la curación y la paz. Se ha actualizado la lista de infractores del clero comprobados de la Arquidiócesis en el sitio web. Se puede encontrar un enlace en la página de inicio de la Arquidiócesis en www.archkck.org.

La Arquidiócesis de Kansas City en Kansas toma muy en serio todas las acusaciones de mala conducta por parte del personal de la iglesia y trabaja para responder a las necesidades de los sobrevivientes con urgencia, respeto y compasión. Alentamos a cualquier persona que tenga conocimiento de cualquier mala conducta por parte de un voluntario, empleado, religioso o miembro del clero de la iglesia, independientemente de cuándo haya ocurrido el abuso, a que se comunique primero con las autoridades civiles y luego presente un informe a nuestra línea de denuncia confidencial al (913) 647-3051 o en línea en www.archkck.org/reportabuse. Nos preocupamos por los sobrevivientes de abuso. Puede comunicarse con los defensores de atención a las víctimas al (913) 298-9244 o al (913) 433-6701".

Esta es una noticia triste. Además de informar adecuadamente, si alguien tiene alguna inquietud o desea hablar conmigo, comuníquese conmigo en la oficina parroquial. Oremos por las víctimas de abusos por parte de un representante de la Iglesia, para que puedan encontrar curación de estos terribles crímenes.
