Our month of October is coming to a close. All Hallow's Eve will soon be upon us, and then the month of November opens up with us remembering the saints and all those who have gone home to the Lord.

Wednesday, November 1, is All Saints Day. This is a holy day of obligation. We remember those who have lived a good, holy life and set a good example for us. Mass will be celebrated 3 times on All Saints Day—our regular 8:30 mass in the morning, followed by mass at 12:15, and then again at 6:00 in the evening. Thursday, November 2, is All Souls Day. We remember all who have died and have gone home to the Lord. Our mass on Thursday will be the regular 8:30 mass. You are invited to bring a picture of your loved ones who have passed, and place it on one of the tables in front of the altar. The picture will remain there until after mass. Names of all who have been buried from our church in the past year will be read during mass.

Because we remember the dead at the beginning of November, we are encouraged to visit the cemetery where loved ones are buried to pray and perhaps take care of things around the grave before Winter sets in. The Church encourages us to visit the cemetery often throughout the year, praying for, and remembering the dead.
