FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We are now a week into October which is traditionally celebrated as Respect Life Month. This month we offer a special focus on the dignity of the human person and we pray in a particular way for our society to change from a culture of death to a culture of life. October is also the month of the Rosary. I do not believe that this is a coincidence, that the month we are called to pray for a greater respect for human life is the month in which we acknowledge Our Blessed Mother and her special gift to us in the rosary.

I invite everyone in the parish to foster a greater devotion to our Blessed Mother, especially through frequent, even daily recitation of the rosary. I also encourage you, along with growing in devotion through the Rosary, to offer the rosary with regularity for a greater respect for human life. While there are many fronts on which we strive to foster the culture of life, legislative and political, communication and outreach, personal and practical, we also foster this on a spiritual level. St. Paul reminds us, "For our struggle is not with flesh and blood but with the principalities, with the powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the heavens. Therefore, put on the armor of God, that you may be able to resist on the evil day and, having done everything, to hold your ground". (Ephesians 6:12-13) We cannot deny that the incredible disrespect for human life in our society today, certainly apparent in the common practice of abortion and the growing movement to legitimize euthanasia, is a great evil. How can a society that does not respect the innocent unborn or the elderly and infirm truly respect those who are poor, alone, addicted, homeless? Can we truly be surprised to see so much civil unrest, crime, animosity, and hate when, as a society, we have so damaged our conscience by fostering the culture of death?

We must pray for heaven's help, for our Blessed Mother's help, in changing our culture. Let us use the rosary, this incredible gift that she has given us, to foster the culture of life in our homes and families, in our social circles and in our parish so that the culture of life will grow in our cathedral parish and spread beyond our boundaries.

The Lord is the Lord of life, and He has won the victory over sin and death. Let us unite ourselves with Him and share the Gospel of Life, the incredible dignity each and every human being has as we are made in the image and likeness of God. Let us foster the hope that the Lord offers to everyone, even when we face so many challenges and crises in our lives, and let us be a source of hope and support those who are struggling, those who feel abandoned, those who feel desperate, so that they will feel our love and care for them and embrace the culture of life.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

Estamos a una semana de octubre, que tradicionalmente se celebra como el Mes del Respeto a la Vida. Este mes ofrecemos un enfoque especial en la dignidad de la persona humana y oramos de manera particular para que nuestra sociedad cambie de una cultura de muerte a una cultura de vida. Octubre es también el mes del Rosario. No creo que esto sea una coincidencia, que el mes en el que estamos llamados a orar por un mayor respeto a la vida humana sea el mes en el que reconocemos a Nuestra Santísima Madre y su regalo especial para nosotros en el rosario.

Invito a todos en la parroquia a fomentar una mayor devoción a nuestra Santísima Madre, especialmente a través del rezo frecuente e incluso diario del rosario. Les animo también, además de crecer en la devoción a través del Rosario, a ofrecerlo con regularidad para un mayor respeto a la vida humana. Si bien hay muchos frentes en los que nos esforzamos por fomentar la cultura de la vida, legislativa y política, de comunicación y promoción, personal y práctica, también fomentamos esto a nivel espiritual. San Pablo nos recuerda: "Pues no nos estamos enfrentando a fuerzas humanas, sino a los poderes y autoridades que dirigen este mundo y sus fuerzas oscuras, los espíritus y fuerzas malas del mundo de arriba. Por eso pónganse la armadura de Dios, para que en el día malo puedan resistir y mantenerse en la fila valiéndose de todas sus armas". (Efesios 6:12-13) No podemos negar que la increíble falta de respeto por la vida humana en nuestra sociedad actual, ciertamente evidente en la práctica común del aborto y el creciente movimiento para legitimar la eutanasia, es un gran mal. ¿Cómo puede una sociedad que no respeta a los inocentes no nacidos, a los ancianos y a los enfermos respetar verdaderamente a los pobres, los solos, los adictos y los sin hogar? ¿Podemos realmente sorprendernos de ver tanto malestar civil, crimen, animosidad y odio cuando, como sociedad, hemos dañado tanto nuestra conciencia al fomentar la cultura de la muerte?

Debemos orar por la ayuda del cielo, por la ayuda de nuestra Santísima Madre para cambiar nuestra cultura. Usemos el rosario, este increíble regalo que ella nos ha dado, para fomentar la cultura de la vida en nuestros hogares y familias, en nuestros círculos sociales y en nuestra parroquia para que la cultura de la vida crezca en nuestra parroquia catedral y se extienda más allá.

El Señor es el Señor de la vida y ha ganado la victoria sobre el pecado y la muerte. Unámonos a Él y compartamos el Evangelio de la Vida, la increíble dignidad que tenemos todos y cada uno de los seres humanos al estar hechos a imagen y semejanza de Dios. Fomentemos la esperanza que el Señor ofrece a todos, incluso cuando enfrentamos tantos desafíos y crisis en nuestra vida, y seamos fuente de esperanza y apoyo a quienes luchan, a quienes se sienten abandonados, a quienes se sienten desesperados, para que sientan nuestro amor y cuidado y abracen la cultura de la vida.
