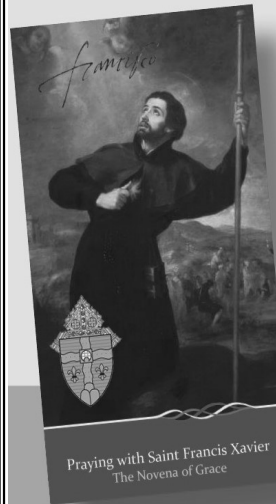
It’s Finally Here!!
