### From the Pastor's Desk


Today the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Christ the King. On this 34<sup>th</sup> and final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Church officially concludes the liturgical year of 2020 and anticipates the arrival next Sunday of the season of Advent. In the Gospel this Sunday Jesus describes for us the Final Judgment. The Son of Man will separate the sheep (the blessed) from the goats (the accursed) by evaluating them on the Corporal Works of Mercy: (1) Feeding the hungry, (2) Giving drink to the thirsty, (3) Welcoming the stranger, (4) Clothing the naked, (5) Caring for the ill, and (6) Visiting the imprisoned. Whenever we did these works for another, we did them for Jesus. Lord, help us to see these opportunities you give us to serve you in your need.

This weekend we welcome back Ward Qumsieh of Holylands Arts. This is the group with whom our pilgrims traveled one year ago to the Holy Land. Ward is here once again this year to sell hand carved olive wood items, made in the Holy Land, that make wonderful Christmas presents. It also helps put food on the table for many Christian families living in the Holy Land. Please consider making a purchase in support of families maintaining a Christian presence where Jesus lived.

This upcoming January 20/21 (3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time) the Universal Church celebrates the "Sunday of the Word of God." In 2019 Pope Francis proclaimed this annual celebration to highlight the importance of the Word of God in the lives of Catholics. 
