FROM THE RECTOR

It is the Lord who brings us from life to death. It is simple and clear. We need to live in a manner reflecting this faith and confidence. The reality of Christ's victory over death and sin is not only something to be experienced at some future day but also in how we go about our daily lives. In our Gospel today, we witness two people whose faith moves them to seek the Lord to assist with illness and death. This manifested faith involves a profound trust that God will answer their prayers according to His will and providence. In both instances the Lord's mercy moves Him to heal the woman and to raise the child from death to life. Christ desires to do the same for each of us, but we must do our part. First, we must live lives of great faith and trust that the Lord will answer our prayers. Second, we must approach the Lord in times of need. It is foolish to trust in our own devices, to ask men to accomplish for us things only God can do. Confronting illness and its suffering or more serious still the sadness and sorrow of death, human comfort can only do so much. Like the healings in the Gospel, we seek our Lord first and always and strive to live our faith in the Lord each and every day. Finally, in this month of November we should earnest in our intercessory prayers to All Saints and pray fervently for all the Faithful Departed.
