

**Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** Masses in celebration of the gift of Mary's sinlessness in anticipation of the saving acts of Jesus Christ take place:

Thursday, December 7: 5:30 p.m. at SHW; 7:00 p.m. at SMH. Friday, December 8: 8:30 a.m. at SPPN; Noon at ICC; and 5:30 p.m. at SHDC.

There will be no Spanish Mass on Sunday, December 10, and our monthly Healing Service will not take place in December but will resume in January.

Rosary Novena in Intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Between December 3 and December 11, beginning at 6 p.m., at ICC, we will pray a Novena (nine days) of The Rosary to Our Lady of Guadalupe.
