



Mary, on the other hand, from what we know, was more contemplative, and drew very little attention to herself, despite being the most perfect of God's creation. They were certainly set apart. Each of us has a very different role to play in salvation history. Some loud, some quiet, some red martyrdom and some white and some blue. We all are called to proclaim the Gospel.
