

A Message from Fr. Tom Donovan: 2023 Year in Review

As a parish family, we have a lot to be thankful for in 2023. Here are just a few of them, in no particular order... "part 2" will be next week!

Year of Eucharistic Renewal— The US bishops have designated 2022-24 for a time of renewal in order to promote and inspire greater devotion to our Eucharistic Lord. To that end, parishes have been encouraged to focus



Eucharistic mystery through devotions, preaching, and worship opportunities during this time. At St. Anthony, in Advent of 2022 and 2023, the whole parish came together in the observance of "40 hours" of adoration, a traditional devotional practice which is marked not only by the length and intensity of prayer, but by the combined effort on part of the entire community to come together for in these hours of prayer. The national renewal effort will feature a gathering at a Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis in July of 2024.

Diocese of Springfield Eucharistic Congress—In October, nearly 5000 people gathered at the BOS center in Springfield to hear talks by Scott Hahn, Fr. Chase Hilgenbrink, Fr Denis Robinson, OSB and Sr. Karolyn Nunes, FSGM, and participate in a concelebrated

Mass with Bishop Paprocki and nearly all of the priests of the diocese. Videos from the event are available on the Diocese of Springfield YouTube page at: www.youtube.com/diospringfield



The Quincy Catholic School system is closer to being operational. In 2023, Bishop Paprocki gave permission to form a provisional board of governance for a cooperative school system among the four Quincy parishes with schools, with the eye to develop the structures and programs necessary to maintain and promote Catholic Education in Quincy well in to the 21st Century. To these ends, the

pastors hired Dr. Chris Gill, formerly Vice President for Student Affairs at Notre Dame College in Cleveland, OH, to be the inaugural 'chief executive officer' of the system, which hopes to formally



be incorporated in 2024. While visible changes to the school operations and practices will likely not be seen for a few years, the critical organizational and managerial structures are being assembled and a long range plan is being developed for the success of our schools. Monthly updates continue to be published, updating the Catholic community of the progress of this important effort. These updates can be reviewed at quincycatholicschools.org.

Pope Benedict XVI entered into eternal life peacefully on the morning of December 31, 2022 at the age of 95. Funeral services were observed in Rome and a memorial Mass was offered at St. Anthony's.




A Message from Mrs. Carol Frericks—Principal
