

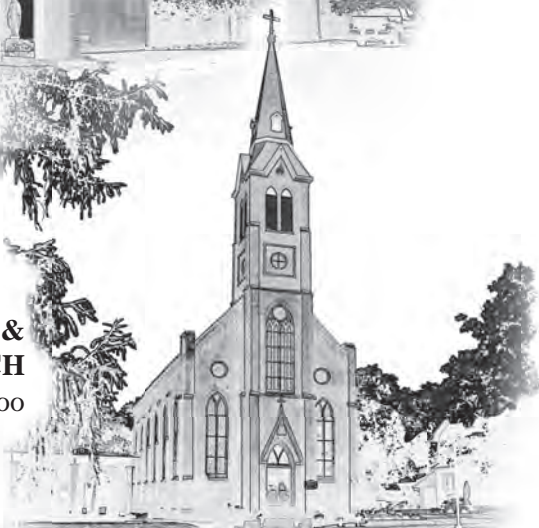

This Year's Sermon Outline, Continued.

Let's begin to take our long, strung-out presentation of the Church's foundational principles of the sexual moral life, by applying them to the teaching on Artificial Contraception. This will include the teaching on Abortion. Keep in mind the following stepping stones serving as our guide: the five dimensions of the human person, man and woman; the three dimensions of society; the natural law and the common good; and the subjective and objective standards of morality.

January 13/14: "Father Bernard Lee Got Somebody Awfully Mad." A story from the Trosley family that perfectly presents the many facets of artificial birth control.

January 20/21: "I Love You Totally...Except For...Well, Not Really...I Guess...But Come On!" Church teaching on artificial birth control from the dimensions of the human person, man and woman: their unity and their dignity.

Another Adjustment with Parish/School Meetings. On the "plus" side, we have tracked the arrival of bills for each institution, so that we can schedule meetings with more accurate financial statements to review. But on the "minus" side, one meeting per week stretches things out way too long for any of our churches to provide consistent, reliable oversight beyond my own responsibilities. Therefore, once we get to February, we will schedule meetings on a Tuesday/Wednesday basis once again; we'll be able to get all of our parish and school meetings "in" before we arrive at Palm Sunday - that's March 24 this year! Easter...March 31!!!

With Gratitude: Care for our Cemeteries. For the past half year, we have been in contact with the State of Illinois for the purpose of arriving at compliance with regulations governing the records and the upkeep of our Catholic cemeteries. Things have stretched out a bit; we have to make sure that we have record of burial permits from the year 2012 onward. There are also a few things we need to do to make sure there is public access to rights with regard to the use of cemeteries. I want to thank all of our people who have so diligently and thoroughly provided oversight and care of our cemetery properties. In the near future, we will be reviving cemetery trustee and committee meetings to make sure that once we are current, we stay current.

Thank you, St. Mary Parishioners! Your generosity is overwhelming! We have been able to rise to the challenge of the matching grant, going so far as to exceed our goal! Special thanks to our trustees, our Finance Council, and to all of you who helped with this much-needed project.
