FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As we begin to roll out the annual Archbishop's Call to Share (ACTS) we have received the parish goal of raising \$26,759. Last year we met our goal, and even surpassed it a little bit. I would love to see the same this year, but even more so, I would love to see a wider participation from our parish family. Last year our participation in ACTS was around 38%. I am so grateful to that 38% for participating and support this effort in our Archdiocese to minister to everyone in Northeast Kansas. But the remaining 62% who did not participate presents a reality check for us. It is very common in every initiative and in every activity that a minority of people offer the majority of the support. This is true of our weekly offerings, of our parish programming, funeral luncheons, along with wider efforts. What so often happens is the smaller group that offers the greater labor or support will wear out. Yet the larger group which does not engage still expects the same programming and activity. Our ministries, our activities, our very existence as a parish and as a local church does not just happen. It is not simply here. It requires support and participation to continue and to thrive.

I would like to challenge everyone who has not participated in ACTS or who does not regularly tithe to truly engage and discern some participation. I certainly understand that times are difficult. I know that inflation and rising grocery prices are hurting many. We have had to make adjustments. But the parish is affected by these things too, as is the Archdiocese. So my challenge is this: can you offer even a small gift? Can you engage in this common effort to support our many ministries even with a few dollars? Can you encourage your families members and friends to engage? I would love to see our participation grow this year. I do not expect us to reach 100% participation this year, but can we reach 50%? Can we all engage more in the life of the Archdiocese and in the life of the parish? To the 38% who participated last year, thank you! And please continue to support the ACTS campaign.

Beyond ACTS, can we all engage and support more this wonderful spiritual family that is our parish? I have experienced so many blessings through my own financial support of the parish. The more I give, the more I receive. The more I engage, the greater my experience is of our spiritual family. At the end of the day, everything I have is from God, and through my support of the parish, and ACTS, I can make a small return, a sacrificial offering to the Lord to build up His Kingdom here in KCK. He blesses our generosity. He offers such powerful grace to our charity. Let's not miss this opportunity, or any future opportunities to engage Him and His Church, even in our finances, so that He may be part of everything we do.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

A medida que comenzamos a implementar la campaña anual Todos Llamados a Compartir del Arzobispo (ACTS), hemos recibido la meta parroquial de recaudar \$26,759. El año pasado cumplimos nuestro objetivo, e incluso lo superamos un poquito. Me encantaría ver lo mismo este año, pero aún más, me encantaría ver una participación más amplia de nuestra familia parroquial. El año pasado nuestra participación en ACTS rondaba el 38%. Estoy muy agradecido con ese 38% por participar y apoyar este esfuerzo en nuestra Arquidiócesis para ministrar a todos en el noreste de Kansas. Pero el 62% restante que no participó nos presenta una prueba de la realidad. Es muy común en cada iniciativa y en cada actividad que una minoría de personas ofrezca la mayor parte del apoyo. Esto se aplica a nuestras ofrendas semanales, a nuestra programación parroquial, a los almuerzos fúnebres y a esfuerzos más amplios. Lo que sucede muy a menudo es que el grupo más pequeño que ofrece mayor trabajo o apoyo se desgastará. Sin embargo, el grupo más grande que no participa todavía espera la misma programación y actividad. Nuestros ministerios, nuestras actividades, nuestra existencia misma como parroquia y como iglesia local no sucede por casualidad. No está simplemente aquí. Requiere apoyo y participación para continuar y prosperar.

Me gustaría desafiar a todos los que no han participado en ACTS o que no ofrecen limosna regularmente a participar verdaderamente y discernir alguna participación. Ciertamente entiendo que los tiempos son difíciles. Sé que la inflación y el aumento de los precios de los alimentos están impactando a muchos. Hemos tenido que hacer ajustes. Pero la parroquia también se ve afectada por estas cosas, al igual que la Arquidiócesis. Entonces mi desafío es este: ¿puedes ofrecer algo aunque sea un pequeño? ¿Puedes participar en este esfuerzo común para apoyar a nuestros numerosos ministerios, incluso con unos pocos dólares? ¿Puedes animar a tus familiares y amigos a participar? Me encantaría ver crecer nuestra participación este año. No espero que alcancemos el 100% de participación este año, pero ¿podremos llegar al 50%? ¿Podemos todos involucrarnos más en la vida de la Arquidiócesis y en la vida de la parroquia? Al 38% que participó el año pasado, ¡gracias! Y por favor continúe apoyando la campaña ACTS.

Más allá de ACTS, ¿podemos todos involucrarnos y apoyar más a esta maravillosa familia espiritual que es nuestra parroquia? He experimentado tantas bendiciones a través de mi propio apoyo financiero a la parroquia. Cuanto más doy, más recibo. Cuanto más me comprometo, mayor es mi experiencia de nuestra familia espiritual. Al final del día, todo lo que tengo es de Dios, y a través de mi apoyo a la parroquia y ACTS, puedo hacer un pequeño regreso, una ofrenda de sacrificio al Señor para construir Su Reino aquí en KCK. Él bendice nuestra generosidad. Él ofrece una gracia tan poderosa a nuestra caridad. No perdamos esta oportunidad, ni ninguna oportunidad futura, de involucrarlo a Él y a Su Iglesia, incluso en nuestras finanzas, para que Él pueda ser parte de todo lo que hacemos.

Totus Tuus is now accepting applications for Summer 2024 Missionaries. In order to make Totus Tuus a success, awesome faith-filled missionaries are needed...both men and women! **JOB DESCRIPTION:** The Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas is seeking missionaries for the 2023 Totus Tuus team. Missionaries will travel to parishes in the archdiocese, spending a week at each parish and running programs for elementary aged children during the day and teens during the evening.
