Primera lectura

Jon 3, 1-5. 10

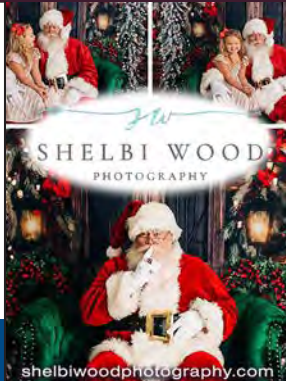
