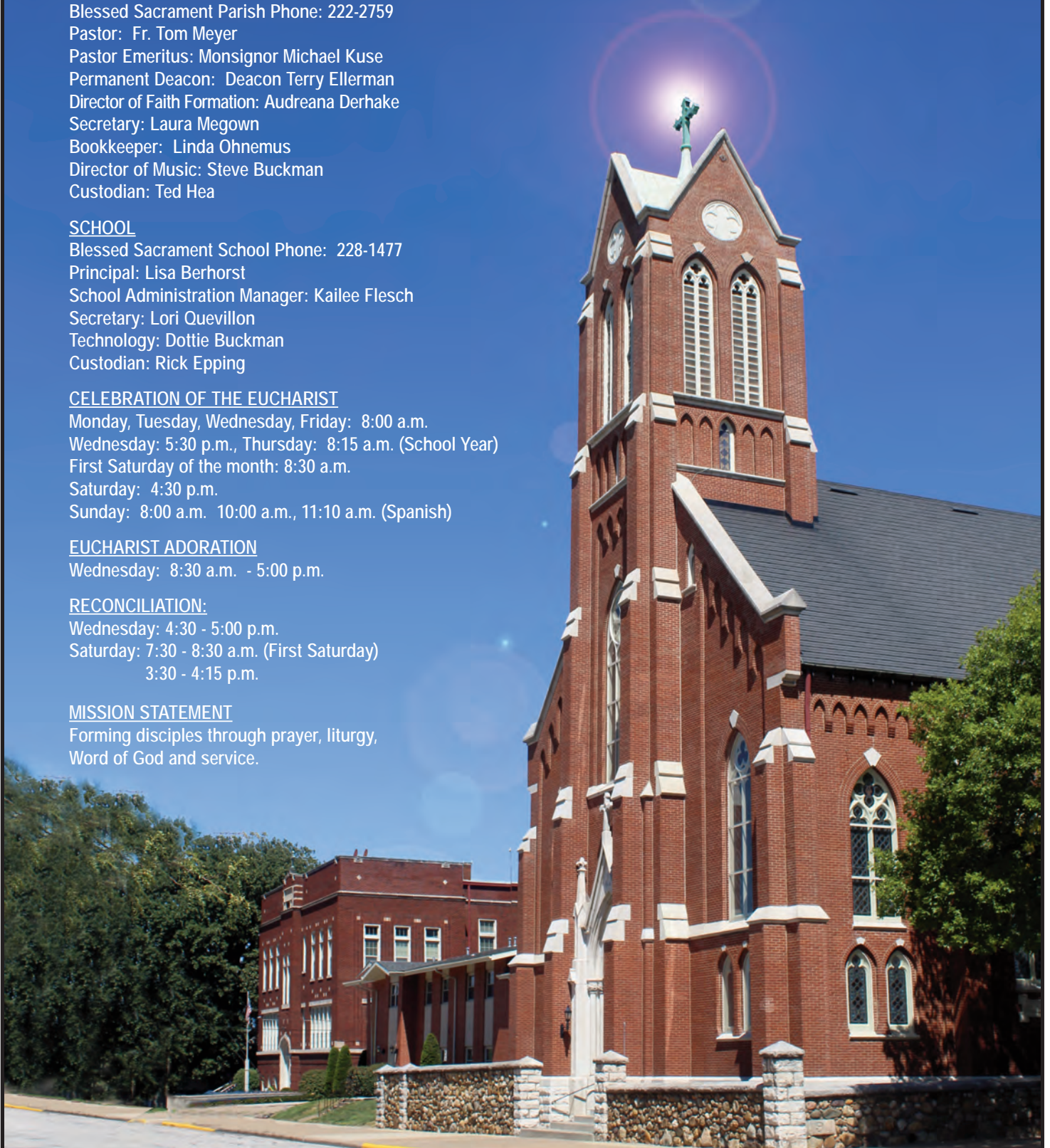

**From the Pastor's Desk**

Today we celebrate the **6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**. In the gospel Jesus heals a man with leprosy. According to the laws of the Old Testament those with leprosy were to be excluded from society. "He shall dwell apart, making his abode outside the camp." Jesus' heart was moved with pity for this heartbreaking situation, and brings healing. We pray that our own hearts may have an awareness for those who carry hidden wounds of separation. We too wish to be ministers of healing.

This weekend (February 10 -11) at all Masses we celebrate our annual **Blessing for those Celebrating significant wedding anniversaries**. We congratulate our married couples celebrating special anniversaries this year!

This weekend at all Masses I am **Commissioning our New 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Altar Servers**. We thank them for saying "yes" to this important liturgical ministry at Blessed Sacrament Parish.

This upcoming Wednesday marks the beginning of the season of Lent as we celebrate **Ash Wednesday**. Our Ash Wednesday liturgies will be celebrated at the following three times:

8:15 a.m. Mass  
4:00 p.m. Spanish Mass  
5:30 p.m. Mass

**From the Pastor's Desk Continued**

The season of **Lent** should include the following elements for us to focus upon: (1) Fasting -giving up something we like; (2) Prayer; and (3) Charity - doing charitable works for others and donating money to charity. Blessed Sacrament will provide several liturgical and devotional opportunities each week during Lent to assist you in your spiritual growth during this Lenten season.

**6:00 p.m.: Stations of the Cross (Church)**

The following are the **Lenten regulations** for Catholics to observe.

Abstinence - Everyone 14 years of age and over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Friday's of Lent.

Fast - Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 is required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Only one full meatless meal, and two much smaller meatless meals, are permitted. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.

Next Sunday, February 18 at 2:30 p.m. our RCIA catechumens travel to Springfield for the **Rite of Election**. At this celebration Bishop Thomas Paprocki officially welcomes all catechumens into the order of the "Elect". Next weekend we will celebrate a Rite of Sending before their departure. We pray for our RCIA catechumens and candidates as they begin their final preparations for the Easter sacraments.

On Friday's at 5:30-6:00 p.m. in the upcoming Season of Lent, I will be presenting a **6-part weekly Lenten Meditations on the "Passion according to St. Mark."** Each weekly meditation is only 30 minutes long. I hope it might be a nice way to prepare for the Passion Reading that we will hear this upcoming Palm Sunday. Our Friday evening Lenten schedule will therefore look like this:

**5:30-6:00 p.m. Lenten Meditation on Passion according to St. Matthew**  
**6:00-6:30 p.m. Stations of the Cross**

Finally, also during this upcoming season of Lent we will celebrate a **40 Hours Devotion on the weekend of March 8-10**. This devotion consists in 40 straight hours of Eucharistic Adoration, marking the 40 hours that Jesus spent in the tomb. For these 40 hours we are asking for parish members to sign up for one hour of Eucharistic Adoration from Friday 4:00 p.m. through Sunday 8:00 a.m. We will have several ways for parish members to sign up: online (Sign-up Genius) or on paper. Please consider offering one hour during this time as part of your upcoming Lenten offering.
