Sunday, February 11 is World Day of the Sick. February 11 is also the day we remember Our Lady of Lourdes. May we ask the intercession of the Blessed Mother to look after all who are sick and in need of healing. May God have mercy on us in our time of need.

Yes, it is hard to believe, but Lent starts this week on Ash Wednesday—also Valentine's Day. Eat your Valentine chocolates before Wednesday; otherwise I know you may want to wait until Easter Sunday if you are giving up candy for Lent!

Our Lenten season is a penitential one. This season prepares us for the great celebration of Easter. As we begin this holy time, I ask you to think of some things that are important to you in your relationship with Christ. Now, how will you achieve those important things? Lent is a good time to do this, as it is designed to "slow" us down from our regular routine. Prayer, going to mass, receiving the sacrament of Reconciliation, doing without—these are all things we can do to make our Lenten Journey special.

Ashes will be distributed 4 times here in the parish. Mass with ashes will be held at our regular time of 8:30 and again at 6:00 in the evening. A Liturgy of the Word with ashes will be held at 12:15 and 4:00. These ashes that are marked upon us remind us quite simply that we are dust, and back to dust we shall return. However, our soul will continue to live in a new way.
