

Lent Begins on Wednesday, February 14 (Ash Wednesday) Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday - Days of fast and abstinence. The obligation to abstain from meat bind Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to fast, limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals, binds Catholics from the age of 18 to 59.

Other Fridays of Lent - Also days of abstinence from meat.

Stations of the Cross - The majority of the questionnaires that were returned for the preferred time of Stations of the Cross came back with 4:00 p.m.


