## FROM THE DESK OF FATHER SAIKI

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I hope your lent is off to a good start! Even though we have already begun our Lenten observance, it is not too late to form a plan, a concrete way to grow spiritually this lent, and to engage in greater prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

One concrete practice that I encourage everyone to do is to go to confession this lent. If you do not have a regular practice of going to confession, I encourage you to try to go once a month. When we go to confession, we place ourselves at the throne of mercy, we go to the spiritual emergency room, and we receive the divine medicine of grace! Lent is a great time to go to confession, and to foster regular confession to receive forgiveness of our sins and to increase grace in our lives.

Another practice that can greatly enhance our prayer is to meditate on the Scriptures. We can read the Bible every day, choosing books or chapters we wish to read. We can use a particular method to grow in our use of the Bible. We can engage the scriptures more by engaging more the readings of Mass. We have a great gift in our Mass lectionary. Each day the Church offers us particular Scriptures that have a theme and focal point to help us grow in our spiritual lives. When we read the Scriptures, we should pick a particular section, read it once and think about it, read it again and sit in silence with it, and read it a third time and consider how the readings apply to our life. We can apply this method to the readings at Mass, to read the readings before Mass begins, to think about them as Mass begins, to listen to them proclaimed in Mass, to hear what the preacher says about them, and consider how those readings are speaking to us in the particulars of our life.

Parishioner Steven Maurin offered a great suggestion to have a section in our bulletin available for us to fill out, to help us foster our engagement with the readings on Sundays, much like our students and families engages in our catechism classes. You can find that section in the bulletin asking the simple question, "What is the key message each reading gave to me?". I encourage everyone to make use of this section in the bulletin each Sunday, to engage with the readings, and consider how the readings apply to your life. The scriptures always have something to say to us, no matter where we are in life. To hear what they have to say, we have to engage them. I hope this simple practice of filling out what the key message of the readings is for us can enhance our interaction with the readings, with the Word of God, and discover how God speaks to us, and grow in our prayer, our conversation with God.

Queridos Hermanos y Hermanas,

¡Espero que tu cuaresma haya tenido un buen comienzo! Aunque ya hemos comenzado nuestra observancia de la Cuaresma, no es demasiado tarde para formular un plan, una forma concreta de crecer espiritualmente durante esta Cuaresma y participar en una mayor oración, ayuno y limosna.

Una práctica concreta que animo a todos a hacer es confesarse durante esta cuaresma. Si no tienes la costumbre de confesarte, te animo a que intentes hacerlo una vez al mes. Cuando nos confesamos, nos colocamos ante el trono de la misericordia, vamos a la urgencia espiritual y recibimos la medicina divina de la gracia. La Cuaresma es un buen momento para confesarnos y fomentar la confesión regular para recibir el perdón de nuestros pecados y aumentar la gracia en nuestras vidas.

Otra práctica que puede mejorar mucho nuestra oración es meditar en las Escrituras. Podemos leer la Biblia todos los días, eligiendo libros o capítulos que deseamos leer. Podemos usar un método particular para crecer en nuestro uso de la Biblia. Podemos involucrarnos más en las Escrituras al involucrarnos más en las lecturas de la Misa. Tenemos un gran regalo en nuestro leccionario de la Misa. Cada día la Iglesia nos ofrece Escrituras particulares que tienen un tema y un punto focal para ayudarnos a crecer en nuestra vida espiritual. Cuando leemos las Escrituras, debemos elegir una sección en particular, leerla una vez y pensar en ella, leerla de nuevo y sentarnos en silencio con ella, leerla por tercera vez y considerar cómo se aplican las lecturas a nuestra vida. Podemos aplicar este método a las lecturas en la Misa, leer las lecturas antes de que comience la Misa, pensar en ellas cuando comienza la Misa, escucharlas proclamadas en la Misa, escuchar lo que el predicador dice sobre ellas y considerar cómo se interpretan esas lecturas, y considerar como están hablándonos en los detalles de nuestra vida.

El feligrés Steven Maurin ofreció una gran sugerencia de tener una sección en nuestro boletín disponible para que la completemos, para ayudarnos a fomentar nuestro compromiso con las lecturas de los domingos, de manera muy similar a como nuestros estudiantes y familias que participan en nuestras clases de catecismo. Puedes encontrar esa sección en el boletín con la simple pregunta: "¿Qué mensaje es recibido de las lecturas?". Animo a todos a hacer uso de esta sección del boletín cada domingo, a participar en las lecturas y a considerar cómo se aplican las lecturas a tu vida. Las Escrituras siempre tienen algo que decirnos, sin importar dónde nos encontremos en la vida. Para escuchar lo que tienen que decir, tenemos que involucrarlas. Espero que esta simple práctica de completar cuál es el mensaje clave de las lecturas para nosotros pueda mejorar nuestra interacción con las lecturas, con la Palabra de Dios, y descubrir cómo Dios nos habla, y crecer en nuestra oración, nuestra conversación con Dios .

## FISH FRY—PESCADO FRITO

The Knights of Columbus Jose Sanchez del Rio, invites you to come by every Friday of Lent to enjoy of a wonderful Fish Fry. Starting on Friday, February 16 at 4 p.m. in the Parish Center. You are welcome to come have dinner before Stations of the Cross which begin at 6 p.m. or right after Stations.

“All persons who have completed their fourteenth year are bound by the law of abstinence” (Canon 1252). The U. S. Catholic Conference of Bishops (USCCB) extended this law to include all Fridays in Lent.

Since Jesus sacrificed his flesh for us on Good Friday, we refrain from eating flesh meat in his honor on Fridays. Flesh meat includes the meat of mammals and poultry, and the main foods that come under this heading are beef and pork, chicken and turkey. While flesh is prohibited, the non-flesh products of these animals are not, things like milk, cheese, butter, and eggs. Fish do not belong to the flesh meat category.

Los Caballeros de Colón José Sánchez del Río, te invitan a cenar todos los viernes de Cuaresma, disfrutando de un maravilloso Pescado Frito. Los invitamos a cenar antes del Vía Crucis, que comienza a las 6:00 p. m., o justo después del Vía Crucis.

“Toda persona que haya cumplido los catorce años está obligada a la ley de abstinencia” (Canon 1252). La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB) amplió esta ley para incluir todos los viernes de Cuaresma.

Dado que Jesús sacrificó su carne por nosotros el Viernes Santo, nos abstendremos de comer carne en su honor los viernes. La carne incluye la carne de mamíferos y aves, y los principales alimentos que se incluyen en este epígrafe son la carne de res y de cerdo, el pollo y el pavo. Si bien la carne está prohibida, los productos no cárnicos de estos animales no lo están, como la leche, el queso, la mantequilla y los huevos. El pescado no pertenece a la categoría de carne.


