
Archbishop's Call to Share

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION ON THE FRIDAYS OF

LENT ~ As an opportunity for our parish to have Eucharistic Adoration available, we will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament occurring right after the 8:00 a.m. Friday morning Mass. Adoration will occur until 6:45 p.m. There will be Benediction, followed by the Stations of the Cross at 7:00 p.m. There are sign-up sheets in the back of the Church to commit to an hour of Adoration.

Mass Intentions ~ To remember a loved one who has died, or to honor and pray for intentions of another is a beautiful way to call upon God's blessing. The typical sacrificial offering is \$10 a Mass. Request a Mass intention for someone by contacting the parish office.

Candles for Uplift ~ This outreach program is in need of wax to make candles for the homeless. Even crayons can be melted down and used. The homeless use candles for heat and light. A collection tub is located at the East entrance. As the days grow shorter and the temperatures drop, these candles become more important

FASTING & ABSTAINING DURING LENT

WHEN DO WE DO THIS?

FAST & ABSTAIN: Ash Wednesday & Good Friday

ABSTAIN: All Fridays during Lent

WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

FASTING: Eating one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. **ABSTINENCE:** Refraining from eating meat

WHO NEEDS TO FAST & ABSTAIN?

FAST: Ages 18-59
ABSTAIN: 14 and older
