Facilitator - Heidi Becker	The bride or groom must be registered in the parish for a minimum of six months before preparation for marriage will begin. The bride or groom registered in the parish is expected to be actively participating in the life of the Church by living the Stewardship Way of Life. Please contact the Pastor to begin. Dates for the weddings will only be scheduled AFTER meeting with the Pastor. Do not schedule, commit to, or make down payments for venues, caterers, musicians, photographers, etc. until you have met with the Pastor. ## Lent Begins on Wednesday, February 14 (Ash Wednesday) Lenten Regulations

**Ash Wednesday & Good Friday** - Days of fast and abstinence. The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to fast, limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals, binds Catholics from the age of 18 to 59.

**Other Fridays of Lent** - Also days of abstinence from meat.

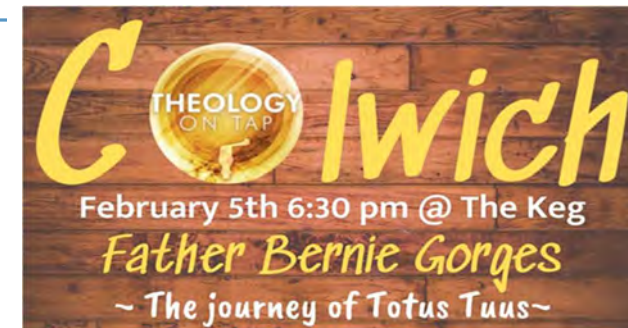
## February 4 - Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
